HILL TAKES AAU MEN'S OUTDOOR PENTATHLON TITLE

FORT COLLINS, Colo., July 16, 1977 --- Former University of Colorado standout Mike Hill easily took top honors in the Amateur Athletic Union's National Men's Outdoor Pentathlon Championships here, winning four of five events.

Hill, now living in Boulder, Colo., and competing for the Colorado Track Club, leaped 24 feet, four inches in the long jump, tossed the javelin 195-11, sprinted 200 meters in 22.8 and ran the 1500 meters in 4:32.5 --- all top performances --- and was second in the discus at 132-4 for a total of 3742 points.

Steve Brittenham of the University of Colorado was runnerup with 3367. Craig Brittenham, Steve's brother, was the top high school performer with 2545. Steve and Craig's dad, Colorado track coach Dean Brittenham, had the top masters' mark with 1800 points.
