CANBERRA, OCT. 30/31--The brand new 300.000 dollar Olmyprene track at the six-million National Stadium had it's first major test at the Australian selection trials for the 3rd Pan Pacific Games Conference on Dec. 3/4.

Hot and windy conditions were not conducive for fast times, but the track is good. Some of the nations' top athletes did not take part through injuries.

Twenty-two men and thirteen women were chosen. The biggest shock was the omission of Raelene Boyle, who, owing to little training and a sore leg, finished a close third in the 100m and withdrew from 200m. However, Raelene has never let Australia down and it is hard to reason with the selectors logic to leave her out of team. Raelene now is dete mined more than ever to retain the national titles next March and to bid for gold medals at the 1978 Commonwealth wames at Edmonton.

The best men's mark at the trials was Don Commons regular TJ of 16.55 Bev Francis (22) set new SP record of 16.42 and Denise Robertson showed some of her old form with 23.1 for 200m.
