Quakes Tip Diplomats On Mitic's Kicks, 3-

Ilija Mitic scored two goals within two minutes the second half yesterday to lift the San Jose Earthquakes to a 3-1 victory in a North American Soccer League exhibition game against the Washington Diplomats at Balboa Stadium.

About 2000 persons saw the Quakes take a 1-0 lead 43 minutes into the first half on John Smillie's 20-yard boot off a pass from Manny Hernandez. But one minute later Washington's Randy Garber tied the score with a 18-yard kick.

Thirty-five minutes into the second half, Mitic scored the ball from Alan Spavin and hit the net with his second 18-yarder. Less than two minutes later, Mitic scored a penalty kick at
