ARRIOLA BREEZES IN MILE, 880

Ed Arriola of the Maccabi Track Club won the mile and 880 Saturday in the Compton Invitational track and field meet at Compton College.

Arriola breezed to a 4:06.8 victory in the mile, then returned to take the half mile in 1:51.6.

Top marks included 53-9 by Olympian Rayfield Dupree in the triple jump, 250-6 by Fred Carpenter of Athletes in Action in the javelin, 16-6 by Terry Porter of the Houston Hurricanes in the pole vault and 13.7 by Mike Johnson of USC in the high hurdles.

The meet, being held after a five-year absence, drew an estimated 3,000 fans.

Olympic champion Edwin Moses, scheduled to compete in the 400-meter hurdles, did not show. Reportedly he is en route to Italy to compete in a meet.
