WINNER'S QUOTES

PAUL CRAIG - One Mile Runner - "I got to the inside quick and got the lead and that set me up for the race. (About foreigners on teams) "Well that is kind of tough because I'm from Toronto. But, bringing in foreigners is OK but not 60% of the team." There are many sports where members are not from their native country, but that's OK to some extent.

DAVID DUNCAN - 120 High Hurdler - The weather effected me and took me off my race about 2/10 seconds.

GEARY HARRIS - 440 - I went out faster than usual but I knew I had to because the guy from UTEP was with me from the very start. The guy from UTEP was leading until the last stretch and that's when I really turned it on.

JOHNNY JONES - 100 Meters - It was pretty fast field, but I imagine the weather is bothering just about everyone today. I was feeling pretty tight the entire race.

RANDY WILSON - 880 - McCall usually tries to jump out quickly- Around the second lap he tried to take the inside and did; but I just thought to myself - stay with him. In the back stretch that's when I knew I had him.

WILLIAM SNODDY - OU - 220 YARD DASH - I was disappointed that Jones (Texas) did not run in the 220. I was really looking forward to it. The 220 was my race and they can have all the rest of them. I was disappointed in my 100 yard race. I used Knobby spikes in the 100 but I switched to the pin spikes and it made a difference. The water was deep on the track on the curves but it wasn't slippery.

COACH BOB TIMMONS - KANSAS - When asked about the incimate weather Coach Timmons replied "This is good weather for Kansas." "The meet was in doubt as long as UTEP had a pole vaulter still in the competition." "Since this was our first meet I was tickeld to win it." It was really tight going into the last relay. When asked about UTEP he said "They're just about as tough as anyone I have ever seen." They rantthe meet exactly as I figured.

COACH CLEBURNE PRICE - TEXAS - When asked about scratching the 440 relay "Raymond Clayborn got a knot in his leg earlier today and I just didn't want to take the change of hurting it anymore." About finishing fifth "I knew that we would finish around fourth or fifth so I wasn't very surprised." "I just wished that we would have had had better weather." "Nobody likes running in the rain."

Notes

Note Waigwa let Craig get too far ahead. The 56.2 is good for dry track, so rain obviously did not slow him. just misjudgment.

100m The 100 was shaping up as a good race, but then it started to rain harder. The hurdles race just prior to the 100 with athletes shuddering into hurdles, may have dampened (pun?) the effort for a good time.

Irony Jay (HT) and Akada, who did well in the Montreal rain, had trouble with the Texas rain. Jay withdrew after clearing 6-8. Akada tried at 16, did not make it. If they had gained points, they would have beaten Kansas.
