Warriors ninth behind leader Penn State

Walter second in EAIAW long jump

EAST STROUDSBURG -Senior Donna Walter, who didn't even qualify for the meet last year, finished second in the long jump to give East Stroudsburg State College its only place-winner in the second annual Eastern Association for Intercollegiate Athletics for Women (EAIAW) Track and Field Championships Friday.

Walter leaped a school record 18-71/2, breaking her own mark of 17-91/2 set earlier in meet mark in the 880-yard run the national championship meet at UCLA May 20-21.

The event was won by Patty Knighton of Penn State with a meet record of 18-91/2. The old ley relay, a new event, in mark, which "alter also 1:44.0. topped, was 17-3% set by Janet Lynch of Vermont.

The ESSC senior from Airville was only jumping in the 16-0 range last year and she credits her improvement to a personal development course she took at the college.

"In the class, we did weight training and endurance running and it helped me become stronger and get in better condition for the season," Walter Slippery Rock in the discus, 132-11/2; Branwen Smith of Springfield in the shot put, 46-81/4; and Paula Girven of Maryland in the high jump.

Martha Suhayda of Maryland, defending champion in the discus and shot put, had to settle for second place in both events. She was voted the outstanding performer in the field events last year.
