Southern Conn. catches Brandeis

Southern Connecticut scored 14 points in the final two events — the pole vault and shot put — to nip Brandeis for the Eastern Intercollegiate track and field championship, 39-38½, at Tufts yesterday.

Favored Brandeis had a healthy lead throughout the meet, and its main concern was Coast Guard, which finished third with 38 points.

That's when Southern Conn. made its move. George Springsteen won the pole vault, which was worth six points, then John Johnston picked up three more with a third, and Pat Hallisey two with a fourth.

That brought it down to the shot put. Brandeis and Coast Guard failed to finish in the top five, and Wayne Durrigan finished third to give Southern Conn. three more points and the title.

The most exciting race of the day was the mile, won by Providence College's John Savoie, who nipped teammate Mike O'Shea. Both runners were clocked at 4:09.4, but Savoie won by eyelash.

The meet produced only one double winner. That was Brandeis's Kim Visbaras, who won the long jump 23 feet, 5½ inches and triple jump (47-2½). Kim won these events back-to-back.

Two meet records were broken. Brandeis's Chris Horton set a record in the 1000 with a 2:10 effort, and Worcester State's John Dupuis set a record in the shot with a put of 58-10½.

Framingham State's David Farnsworth matched the 50-yard dash record with a 5.4 burst.

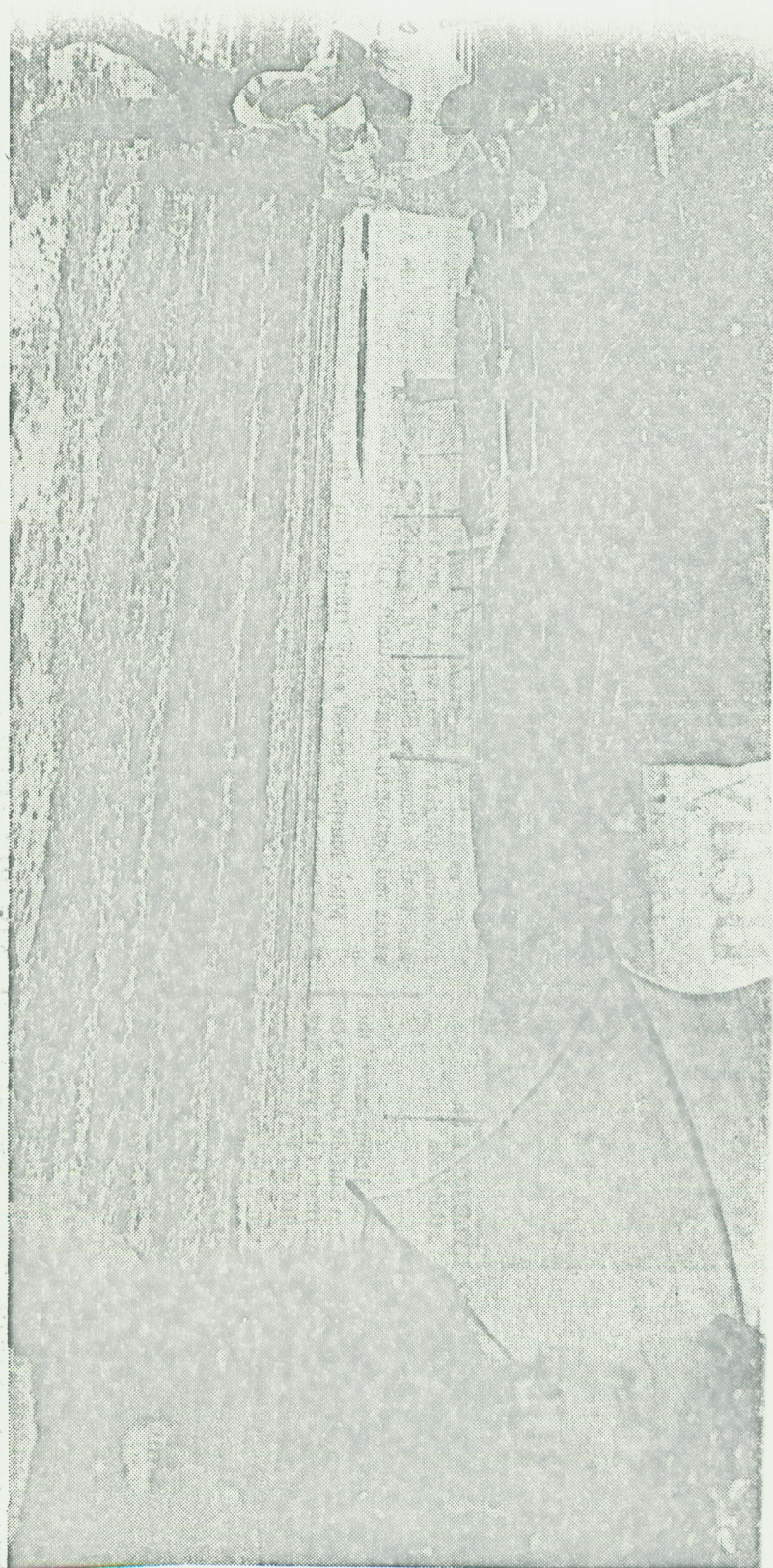
