The HS division could be as exciting as the college division, with Woodson (Wash DC, 3:13.8 last week) shooting for 3:10-11, Kevin Byrne anchoring Paramus Catholic's DMR, and Renaldo Nehemiah, 13.3, aiming at the national record (13.2).

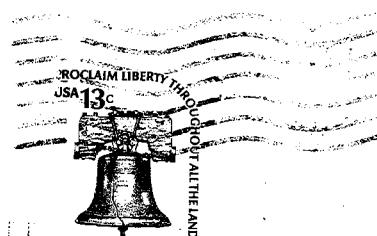
