

WVC'S STEVE ORAVETZ (17-1) & CAMINO'S CHARLIE BROWN (17-1 $\frac{1}{2}$) TOP VAULT; ESSEX 3:18.7 MEDLEY

West Valley College soph Steve Oravetz and El Camino's Charlie Brown bettered the National JC pole vault record of 17-0 $\frac{1}{4}$ in opposite region's of California during March prior to their first scheduled meeting of the year April 9 at the San Jose Relays.

Oravetz went 17-1 on his first try in a Golden Gate Conference double dual meet with College of San Mateo and De Anza, March 19 in his home pit in Saratoga. It's apparent from photos of the vault and Viking coach Bill Campbell's own observation that Oravetz was over by six to eight inches on the record clearance.

Brown, the 1976 California CC champ and national leader with his 16-10 $\frac{3}{4}$ vault in the Metropolitan Conference championships, flirted with the record all last season.

Finally, after hovering between 16-4 and 16-8 for the first month this season, he upped the record to 17-1 $\frac{1}{2}$ March 29 on his second try in a dual meet with visiting Pasadena CC. Brown didn't come closed at 17-4. But, later in the week at the Texas Relays in Austin (April 2), he went over 17-0 to place second to world record breaker Earl Bell's 17-6 vault.

(Previous national record of 17-0 $\frac{1}{4}$ was set by Ralph Haynie, Central Arizona, in the 1974 NJCAA meet.)

ESSEX BREAKS 3:19--Only other national record broken through March was the sprint medley, where Essex County College, N.J., wiped out its own record of 3:19.7 set four years ago at the Florida Relays (with that outstanding quartet of Lawrence Brown, Alf Daley, Horace Tuitt and Ainsley Armstrong).

The Wolverines returned to the same Gainesville meet March 25 to run 3:18.7 to win the open division and 3:21.6 to win the frosh-JC division race the same day.

Oravetz, only a 14-7 vaulter at Campbell H.S. two years ago, improved to 16-1 last year as a West Valley freshman. The 6-1, 160-pounder then kicked-off the 1977 campaign with a 16-7 vault in the Golden Gate Conference Relays, March 5, before getting the record March 19.

He had his most trouble that day at 15-6--taking three attempts; made 16-0 on his first try and 16-6 on his second. He also had three good attempts at 17-6, knocking the bar off on the way down on the last.

His yearly progression has been remarkable; 10-0 as a high school soph, 11-0 as a junior (when he was only 5-6), 14-7 as a senior (at 5-11), then 16-1 and 17-1. But his goal this year is 18 feet.

A math and science major who is probably headed for the University of Washington, Oravetz says, "I like to apply physics to vaulting. And I work on gymnastics more than weightlifting...rings, high bar, ropes. It's important for a vaulter to be able to control his body."
