# Moore Clears 7-0 As Huskies Bow

LONG BEACH, Calif.

— Lucian Moore, a freshman from Franklin-Pierce High of Tacoma, tied the Washington school record of seven feet in the high jump, but the Huskies, in their first outdoor track appearance of the season, bowed to strong Long Beach State.

In the triangular competition, the 49ers had 116 points, UW 82 and Occidental 8. On a dual basis, Long Beach State bested Washington 110-53.

Ken Shannon's team, which competes at San Diego State Saturday, won eight events with Moore's effort the best. His high jump triumph equalled the UW mark set by Darryl Laverdure in 1973.

Hurdler Robert Gaines won the highs in 14.1 and placed third in the 100 meters. Canadian sophomore Scott Nielson won his specialty, the hammer, at 212-2 and picked up a third in the discus.

Other UW winners were: Devon Flynn, 9:09.2 in the steeplechase; Brian Mondscheln, 4:52.4 in the intermediate hurdles; Tom Sinclair, 216-5 in the jav-

elin; Tim Murray, 8:53.0 in the two mile; and Russ Vincent, 60-2½ in the shot put.

Shannon also cited Peter Favell, a freshman from Vancouver, B.C., who clocked 1:53.4 in the 800 meters which was good enough for fourth. He was the top UW finisher in the event.

Greg Gibson, who should be a middle distance mainstay for the Huskies, wound up fourth in the mile, 4:11.9. Gary Gustafson was third in the event at 4:11.5.

"The meet was good for us," Shannon analyzed, "and we have to remember this was our first time outdoors. For Long Beach State, it was the seventh outdoor meet this season. This should wake us up, show us what we have to do."

Washington competed minus distance runner Gordy Braun, discus thrower Robin Earl and javelin thrower Duncan Atwood. They stayed at home because of injuries or family illnesses.

LBS's Jeff Williams had a busy day, winning the 100 and 200 meters and running a leg on the winning 400-meter relay team.
