But Sevigne saw other power signs develop, too.

Keith Whitaker, for instance, stepped a winning 4:05.12 mile, chopping almost three seconds off the senior co-captains's previous personal best.

Harold Stelzer, a junior from Scituate, Mass., looked stronger than a bear in Yellowstone Park on the Fourth of July with a 13:57.1 three-mile.

Lee Kunz, one week out of his - Cornhusker football pads; threw a collegiate career best of 176-1 in winning the discus; 4 + . .

And Ron Fisher, normally a half-miler from Canada, won the 440 intermediate hurdles with a 52.8 in his first competitive experience in the event.

"This was a good meet from the sprints to the three-mile," Sevigne observed "There were very few cheap points. That's the type of tuneup you want two weeks before the Big Eight."

Nebraska's Jeff Lee, the NCAA indoor hurdle champion, showed the effects of being eight pounds over his ideal track weight and the loss of timing caused by spring football. He was beaten fairly easily by Missouri's Godwin Obasogie in the 120 highs.

Nebraska freshman Scott Poehling and . junior teammate Paul McClain did not win Saturday, but both posted personal bests in the 880 with clockings of 1:50.2 and 1:51.7, respectively.

Poehling, carrying what he considers 10 extra pounds, did not see Scott Clark coming out of the final curve behind him and the Missouri runner beat Poehling to the finish line in 1:49.8.

Bellevue's Mark Fluitt was a prime example of Nebraska's late season development. He clipped eight seconds off his previous best mile in a 4:08.7 third place finish.

Missouri's Ed Ofili swept the sprints. whisking to a :09.4 in the 100 and a :21.3 in the 220. His century bettered by a tenth of a second a meet record shared by Nebraska's Charlie Greene in 1965 and Missouri's Mel Gray in 1970.
