Three Indoor Marks Broken

Three University of Montana
indoor records were broken and
another was tied at the Mont-
ana-Montana State open dual
track meet Friday night at Adams
Field House.

Montana's Steve Morgan set a
new standard in the high jump
and teammate Dale Glem low-
ered the mark in the 600-yard
run. Former MSU athlete Joe
Stanbury, competing unat-
tached, sailed to a new record in
the triple jump and Grizzly Scot
Ferda tied the 50-yard dash re-
cord.

Morgan went 6-9 to shatter his
year-old mark of 6-7 1/4. Jim
Johnson of MSU was second
with an effort of 6-7.

Glem timed 1:15.5 to break
the former record of 1:15.7 set
by Montana's Bob Bronson last
year.

Stanbury recorded 48-3 in
winning the triple jump, break-
ing the old mark was 47-11 set by
Mark Halland of George Fox
University in 1973.

Ferda's clocking of 5.4 tied
the 1973 record of MSU's Mike
Flynn.

No team scores were kept,
but the Grizzlies won all but
three events.
