BARRY STEBBINS DEFENDS DECATHLON TITLE: FORMIDABLE CHALLENGE AWAITS

The 1977 NCAA Division II National Track and Field Championships open today at North Dakota State University's New Track Complex and a two-time defending champion will be the center of attraction.

Barry Stebbins, the Mount St. Mary's athlete, will have that attention focused on him for the next two days. Only four other athletes in Division II history have ever won three titles in the same event and four athletes have a chance to add their names to the list this year but Stebbins gets first crack.

It does not promise to be easy! The field looks impressive. The biggest challenge could come from California-Irvine athlete Mauricio Bardales.

Bardales has already posted a season's best of 7501 points. Stebbins top performance this season has been 7278. Both efforts are better than the existing NCAA record of 7269 points set in 1971 by Steve Gough of Seattle Pacific.

But Bardales is not the only challenge to Stebbins. A pair of athletes are right behind and also over 7000. A Mt. St. Mary's teammate, Tom Delmoor, has a 7078 performance while Tom Swartzell of San Francisco State has totaled 7005. And the competition behind is within reach with three competitors at the 6900 point range.

This is the first competition and you will see action in the 100-meter dash the long jump, the shot put, the high jump, and the 400-meter dash today.

Action continues at 12 noon on Wednesday with competition in the 110 meter High hurdles, the discus,

Close Finish Appears Certain

STEBBINS STALKS NCAA DECATHLON RECORD: BARDALES TRAILS BY 100

Two-time defending NCAA Division II decathlon champion Barry Stebbins of Mount St. Mary's College in Maryland may well be on his way to an all-time Division II decathlon point record! The only question is, will he be able to hold off Mauricio Bardales and the rest of the field??

Stebbins assumed a 100 point lead after the first day of competition Tuesday with a blistering 3847 total. Bardales, the California-Irvine star was second at 3747. But it appears that Bardales could be the stronger of the two when the final five events roll around.

Stebbins had a super effort in the long jump, the second of the first five events on Tuesday. He broke the Division II decathlon record all three times he leaped into the long jump pit.

His jumps of 24-4¼, 24-7, and 24-6½ were spectacularly consistent. The 24-7 jump broke the old standard of 24-1¼ set in 1971 by Steve Gough of Seattle Pacific. It earned Stebbins 919 points, the best point total of the day.

Despite the 100-point lead, things appear to be very close. Bardales is very strong in the javelin and 1500 meters, races where he holds the current decathlon records. Stebbins is the recordholder in the 110-meter high hurdles so the story could be told in the discus and pole vault competition.

But don't forget the rest of the field. John Turek of Cal State at Los Angeles, Bill Lawson of Northern Iowa, and David Stoermer of Western Illinois all appear to be within striking distance. They range from 3653 to 3644.

DECATHLON SEES CHAMPION UPSET BY RECORD PERFORMANCE: FULL SLATE TODAY

BARDALES SCORES 7621 POINTS TO COME-FROM-BEHIND

Cal-Irvine star Mauricio Bardales stormed from behind to dethrone two-time defending national champion Barry Stebbins Wednesday in the wrapup of the 2-day decathlon competition to kick off the 1977 NCAA Division II National Track Championships.

Bardales, trailing Stebbins by 100 points entering the second day of competition, put together a record effort in the javelin enroute to all-time highs in points for both a second day and an overall score.

Bardales totalled 7621 to break the old mark of 7269 set back in 1971. He did it with a second day effort of 3874.

The South American native caught Stebbins in the 8th event—the pole vault—and then sealed the victory with a javelin toss of 221-5 in the next to last event.

Stebbins did not go down without a fight. He finished with 7307, a performance also better than the old record.

Stebbins failed in his bid to become the fifth athlete in NCAA II history to win three titles in a single event.

For three other athletes, it did not pay to get up for the second day of competition. John Turek of Cal State-LA, Bob Myers of Cal State-Chico, and Randy Moon of Puget Sound either scratched in the discus or failed to make a height in the pole vault and withdrew. Each was in third place when disaster hit and spoiled their bids for 7000 points.

With the decathlon over, athletes and fans can now turn their attention to a host of other events that begin today.

Seventeen competitions were on the docket for today but several have been scratched and will become semis or finals on Friday and Saturday.

With the loss of Stebbins from the roll of defending champions, nine others are set for action and seven will be in action today.

Steve Scott, the famed junior from Cal-Irvine, will be the feature attraction in the 1500-meter run and the 800-meter run. Scott is the fastest American in the 1500 today and he will double for his team as they seek their second straight title.

His teammate, Mike Sabatino, is the two-time defending champion in the pole vault while high jumper Dave Haber of Cal State-Hayward is going after winning leap number three. Both will be in action today.

The other four in action include Jerry Holloway in the 110-meter high hurdles, Edward Hatch in the 400 meters, steeplechaser Pete Heesen, and 800-meter man William Dabney.

And with a little break in the weather, none of the national marks appear to be safe from what looks to be one of the best fields ever assembled.

CAL STATE-HAYWARD WINS NCAA TITLE

California State University-Hayward got victories in the high jump and triple jump plus a vital third place finish in the 400-intermediate hurdles and then watched as a desperate University of California-Irvine charge came up short as the Pioneers captured the NCAA Division II National Track and Field Championships here Saturday.

Hayward held a 15-point lead over Irvine, the defending national champions, heading into Saturday's final 14 events but could not breathe easy until the final leg of the 1600-meter relay, the final of 21 events over the 5-day meet. The two schools were deadlocked at 56 points each before the Triple jumper John LeGrande leaped 50-feet, 4 and 3/4 inches to capture that event and send Cal State-Hayward into a 66-56 lead with two events remaining.

Cal-Irvine hopes in the final two events rested on the shoulders of 5000-meter ace Ralph Serna and the 1600-meter relay team. Serna, second in the nation in that event in 1976, faded in the last lap to finish fifth and so did most Cal-Irvine hopes. The Anteaters, trailing 66-58, were never close in the 1600-meter relay and the Pioneers of coach Jim Santos had their first NCAA track title ever.

California State-Los Angeles finished third with 51 points whole

Adelphi was fourth at 46 and Western Illinois rounded out the top five with 32.

Three athletes won their third straight crowns. Hayward's Dave Haber put the polish on his third high jump title with a Division II national record 7-2 1/4. Cal-Irvine's Mike Sabatino set a Division II national record in the pole vault with a 17-0 effort as he won his third straight crown. And teammate Steve Scott won for the third time in the 1500 meters with a 3:47.69 clocking as he held off a late charge by host North Dakota State University star Mike Bollmann who finished second at 3:48.49.

Scott came back to become the 18th athlete in Division II history to complete the rare double as he won the 800 meters in 1:51.21. For Scott, it was his fourth NCAA crown and ties him with three others as the only athletes to win that many crowns over a career.

Two other athletes repeated as titlists. East Stromsburg State 3000-meter steeplechaser Pete Hessen grabbed his second straight title in that event with 9:03.52 clocking, joining hammer-thrower Wayne Durrigan of Southern Connecticut State as a two-time champion. Durrigan won his repeat title Friday.

Adelphi University's 1600-meter relay team repeated in that event with a 3:10.97 clocking.
