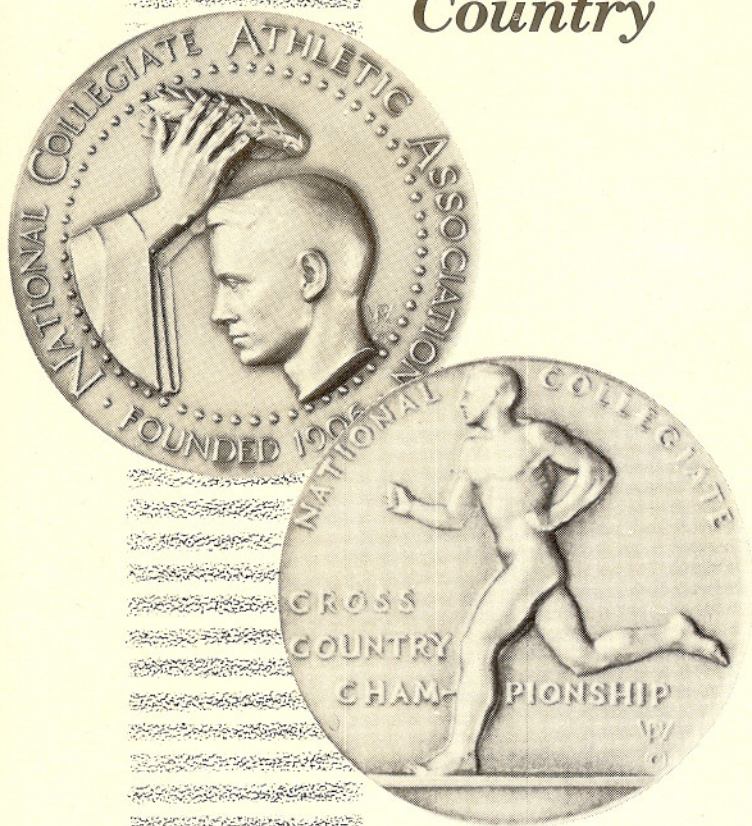

Earle C. (Billy) Hayes Trophy

Since 1945, the Earle C. (Billy) Hayes Trophy has been awarded annually to the institutional winner in the National Collegiate Cross Country Championships. The traveling trophy honors the former Indiana University coach who was one of the organizers of the meet and who helped found the U.S. Cross Country Coaches Association, of which he was president in 1939. Hayes' Hoosiers won the team title in 1938, 1940 and 1942.

1976 Championships

November 22, 1976

TEAM DEPTH again accounted for the National Collegiate Cross Country Championship going to the group from the University of Texas at El Paso. With its top runner finishing no better than sixth individually and fifth in team places, the repeat champion also captured seventh, ninth, 13th and 28th to score 62 points, 55 ahead of Oregon.

Washington State furnished the top two finishers with Henry Rono covering the distance in

28:06.60, 10 seconds faster than teammate Samson Kimombwa. Defending individual champion Craig Virgin, Illinois, followed.

Coach Ted Banks now has annexed six of the past nine available National Collegiate Championships in running sports beginning with the 1974 indoor meet. Overall it is the third National Collegiate Cross Country Championship for the Miners.

1976 Championships

November 13, 1976

RALPH SERNA has run in only two National Collegiate Division II Cross Country Championships, and he has won both of them. California Irvine's sophomore standout crossed the line in the same time, 29:42, as his teammates Eric Hulst and Steve Scott to give the Anteaters the first 1-2-3 finish in the history of the Division II meet while successfully defending their team title. Emporia State managed a 1-2-4 finish in 1963.

Serna is the fifth Division II runner to manage back-to-back wins; and with two years remaining, he could become the first to win three or more. Even worse news for the rest of the teams in Division II is that not one of the runners who scored for Len Miller's champions is a senior.

Fourth place went to Southwest Missouri State's John Prasuhn as he led the host institution to second place in the team competition.

1976 Championships

November 13, 1976

NORTH CENTRAL College successfully defended its National Collegiate Division III Cross Country Championship by edging Humboldt State, 109-132, and rounding out a year in which the defending cross country champion in each NCAA division repeated.

Carleton College's Dale Kramer claimed the individual title and was the only runner to break

25 minutes with his winning time of 24:56. A year ago as a sophomore, Kramer finished 12th.

In the four-year history of the meet, North Central, under the direction of Allen Carius, now has earned two team titles, a tie for second and a third-place finish to establish itself as the prototype of a successful Division III cross country program.

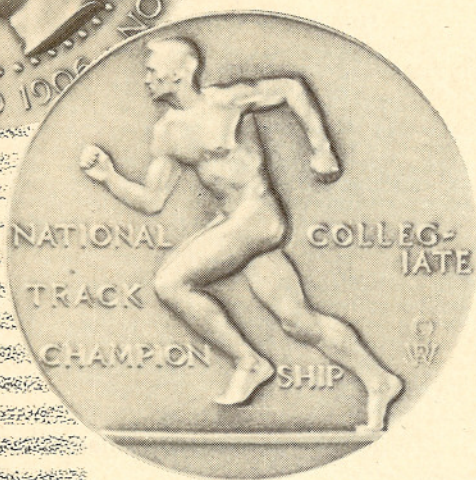
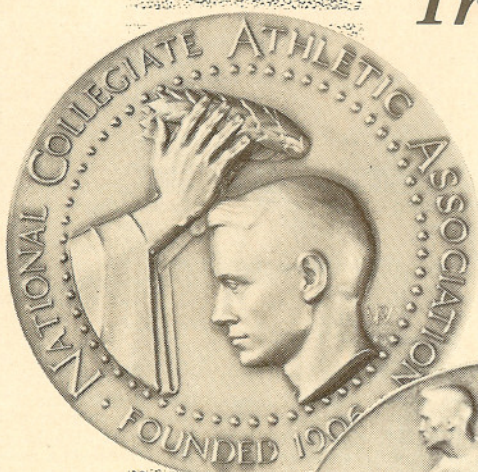

1977 Championships

WASHINGTON STATE'S COUGARS dethroned three-time defending champion Texas El Paso by a mere half-point at the National Collegiate Indoor Track and Field Championships.

Washington State had only two individual champions to three for UTEP, but the Texans lost the crown when two other defending individual titlists could finish no better than third.

Triple-jumper Ian Campbell and two-miler Henry Rono were the Cougars' two first-place finishers, with Rono setting a record of 8:24.83 in his event.

UTEP's first places were charted by miler Wilson Waigwa, high-jumper Greg Joy and its

distance medley relay team. Joy cleared 7-3¼ for a record, and the relay quartet clocked 9:43.11 for another meet mark. The three records by Washington State and UTEP were the only marks established at the meet.

The Miners' distance medley win was a repeat of 1976, and Illinois long-jump star Charlton Ehizuelan earned his second straight title in that event. Joy's victory in the high jump gave him two championships in that specialty, the other coming in 1975. Villanova's Mark Belger copped the 880-yard run crown this time after taking top honors in the 1,000-yard event a year earlier.

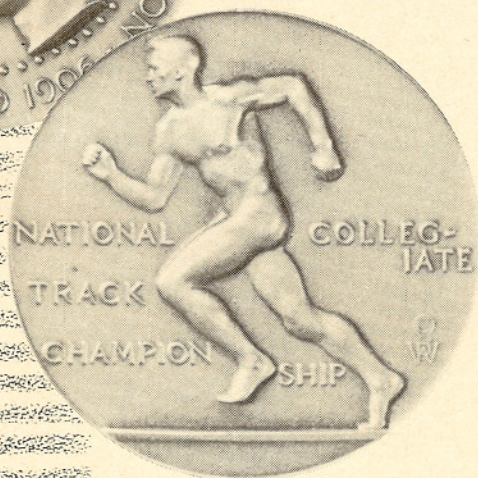
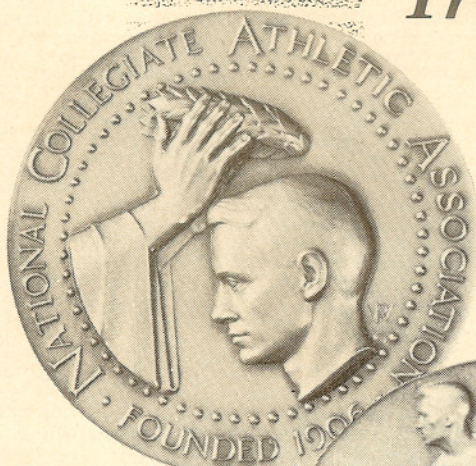

1977 Championships

May 31-June 4, 1977

ARIZONA STATE WON ITS FIRST track and field title by outscoring Texas El Paso, defending champion Southern California and Washington State to win the 1977 National Collegiate Outdoor Track Championships.

The Sun Devils won a pair of individual crowns and amassed 64 points to win the competition. Texas El Paso scored 50 points while Southern California tallied 48 and Washington State 46. Southern California won four individual titles, including both relays, the most of any competing team.

Only three championship records were set during the meet, considerably fewer than the seven established in 1976.

Mark Enyeart of Utah State covered 800 meters in 1:45.16 for one new mark, while a new 10,000-meter record was set by Samson Kimombwa of Washington State with a 28:10.27 time.

The final record established was a field event, with San Jose State's Ron Livers covering 16.86 meters in the triple jump.

HAYWARD STATE WON A PAIR of events to build a big lead and then held off a comeback by defending champ California Irvine to win the 1977 National Collegiate Division II Outdoor Track Championships.

The Pioneers scored 66 points to Irvine's 58 to win the competition, their first NCAA track title. Los Angeles State finished third with 46 points.

Although Irvine didn't defend its team crown, Steve Scott (1,500-Meter Run) and Mike Sabatino (Pole Vault) won individual titles for the

third straight year. Sabatino set a record in the pole vault.

Hayward's Dave Haber also won a third straight title, setting a high jump record, while Mauricio Bardales dethroned Barry Stebbins of Mt. St. Mary's in the Decathlon with a record 7621 points.

Scott, who also won the 800-Meter, was the meet's only double winner. His two victories made him only the fourth athlete ever to win four Division II individual titles.

TEAM BALANCE PROVED THE DECIDING factor as Southern University at New Orleans won its third straight National Collegiate Division III Outdoor Track Championships.

The Black Knights won only two events, but tallied enough points in other events to outscore Occidental, 50-47.

Individual performances highlighted the competition, with Edwin Moses of Morehouse College setting records in both the 110-meter and 400-meter hurdles.

Others who set records included Gordon Innes

of Humboldt State in the 3,000-meter steeplechase, Paul Brown of Westmont in the 100-meter dash, Rudy Beaver of Occidental in the high jump, Tony Hale of Fisk in the decathlon and Mark Linscheid of Lowell in the hammer throw.

Records were also set in the 400-meter relay (Southern) and the 1,600-meter relay (Stanislaus State).

Barry King of Ashland again won the 800-meter run, making him only the second athlete ever to win four titles in Division III track competition.
