MARYVILLE, Mo.--Central Missouri State's Mules and Jennies hooked up to plow under the field Saturday in the first running of the Northwest Missouri State University Track and Field Meet.

The Mules, scoring just three first places but using good depth, topped an eight-school men's field with 85 points. The Jennies, moving to nine first-place finishes, ran roughshod through the four-team women's division, tallying 115 points.

Trailing Central's men were: Doane, 69 points and five first places; NWMSU, 62 points and four firsts; Nebraska-Omaha, 54 points and five firsts; Tarkio, 25 points and two firsts; Washburn, 11 points and one first; Ottawa, nine points and Peru State, four points.

Falling in behind Central's women were NWMSU (86 points and five winners), Washburn (18 points) and Ottawa (12 points and one winner).

Many of the events at the metric distances went in record times because Saturday's action marked the first time they had been contested in Rickenbrode Stadium. But the men snapped two existing Stadium standards and the women toppled five existing marks.

Nebraska-Omaha's two-mile relay unit snapped the record in its specialty with a 7:41.45 clocking. Doane's Rick Cotton topped by over two feet the previous Stadium best in the pole vault when he sailed 16-2 $\frac{1}{4}$.

NWMSU's Linda Martens, a junior from Carson, Iowa, went 5-0 3/8 in the high jump for a Stadium record. Central Missouri's 440 relay team moved to a 48.53 clocking, the Jennies' mile relay unit won in 4:05.77, Central's Stephanie Thompson cracked the 100-meter hurdles mark with a 15.70 clocking and the Jennies' Marilyn Carlson set the 400-meter intermediate hurdles standard in 1:04.76.

Tarkio's Brian Criswell, Northwest Missouri's James Loudill and Vernon Darling were double winners in the men's division. Criswell took the discus (154-5) and the shot put (51-0 3/4). Loudill, a freshman from St. Louis, won the 100 (11.00) and 200 (22.10)-meter dashes. Darling, a junior from Oak Grove, took the 3,000-meter steeplechase (9:22.60) and the 5,000-meter run (14:45.00).

In women's competition, Carlson was a triple winner individually. Besides setting the Stadium mark in the 400-meter hurdles, she won the 400 and 800-meter runs in 56.70 and 2:20.00, respectively, and anchored

the winning mile relay unit. Carlson's teammate, Grace Teevan, took two individual titles, winning the 100 and 200-meter dashes in 12.57 and 25.84, respectively and running on both the 440 and mile relay units.

NWMSU's Ann Kimm, a senior from Norway, Iowa, was the Bearkittens' big winner, taking both the 1,500 and 5,000-meter runs in 4:55.75 and 19:15.13, respectively.

Joining Kimm in the 'Kittens winners circle were Parnell sophomore Julie Schmitz who got off her best long jump as a collegian (second best in 'Kitten history) with a 17-5 $\frac{1}{4}$ leap and Buckner sophomore Kathy Gouldsmith who won the javelin with a 113-4 $\frac{3}{4}$ toss.

The Bearcats get together with Central Missouri and a host of others Tuesday at Warrensburg's Springfest. The Bearkittens next compete Saturday at the Drake Invitational. Next home track action comes April 19 **when** Northeast Missouri State and Graceland send their men's and women's teams to compete against the 'Cats and 'Kittens.
