Discus mark by Winbigler

Lynne Winbigler of the Oregon Track Club bettered her own Hayward Field record in the discus Sunday, throwing 174-6 in a women's all-comer's meet sponsored by the Oregon Track Club and the University of Oregon.

Winbigler eclipsed her old mark of

166-2, set in the 1976 Olympic Trials, on all of her throws. Her impressive series started with 168-6, then 171-1, 167-8, foul, 167-0 and 174-6.

UO freshman Mary Stevenson threw 146-8 for second.

Joy Hall of Southwestern Oregon Community College won the javelin with a toss of 140-1 while OTC's Heather Tolford captured the 1500 in 4:48.2.
