Although it was the Ohio Relays, runners from the State of Michigan dominated, taking no less than 6 relay titles and 5 individual championships. The University of Michigan, lead by a nucleus of Doug Hennigan, James Grace, Arnette Chisolm, and Charles Crouther in the sprints and Andy Johnson and Greg Meyer in the distance events was by far dominant.

The most exciting individual match-up of the
