TSU Relay Team Sets U.S. Record

Southern University's hurdlers got over sticks in a hurry Friday night to set a collegiate record in the 480-yard high shuttle relay — but the Accutrack team-C.J. Gilliam Relays at Southern. Arriving White, James McCraney, Win Mosby and Ricky Davenport as them hurried to a national record of 55.6, bettering the old mark of 55.9 by Florida State and Penn State's team.

be a world record," exclaimed Southern coach Claude Paxton when he noticed the electric device was not running for the shuttle relay race. "Call it a digital watch, hand-held record," Paxton said later. "It's an unofficial record if it has to be on Accutrack because the machine wasn't on. It was supposed to be on but the operator didn't get it on in time."

For a world record to be set, an event must be run in meters and timed electrically. The 480-yard high hurdle shuttle relay is not a world event.

Southern's White, of Fort Lauderdale High, was disappointed that the Accutrack wasn't on but said the team had a chance to officially better the mark at the Drake Relays next week in Des Moines, Iowa.

Activity in the two-day meet begins again Saturday morning at 10 o'clock.

Nathaniel Epps of Southern took first in the 400 meter hurdles with a time of 52.1, and Mary Ayers of Prairie View bested Alice McKnight of Southern in the same race for women. Miss Ayers ran a 1:00.7, and Miss McKnight posted a 1:02.0.

Leading the qualifiers for Saturday night's final in the 110-meter hurdles was Southern's Ricky Davenport, who prepped at Baker High. Davenport was clocked in 13.7 for the best time in the qualifying. Terrone Wright of TSU ran a 13.8, and Jaguar White was also timed in 13.8. Southern's McCraney had a 14.0, and Southeastern's Greg Lawrence came home in 14.1.

Davenport Equals Personal Best, Pam Jiles Stars in Pel Relays

Southern University hurdler Ricky Davenport duplicated his best time ever in his specialty, and Pam Jiles made her sponsors look good at the Pelican-C.J. Gilliam Relays Saturday night at Southern.

Adding to the excitement were double victories by Grambling sprinter Robert Woods, and Kenny August's fine anchoring of two victorious Jaguar baton teams.

Davenport, who came to Southern on a Basic Educational Opportunity Grant before later receiving an athletic scholarship last season, knocked down three hurdles but still ran a 13.7 to win the 110-meter hurdles in the university men's division. Davenport also ran a 13.7 qualifying time Friday night, best time of his career. Southern won the university men's division with 135 points.

A super dame Pam Jiles was on the Southern track. She raced to a 53.7 to win the 400 meters event in women's-club competition, and later toured the 200 meters in 23.5. Woods had the best times in both sprints, winning the shorter one in 10.2 and the furlong in 20.8.

In the 440 relay, Southern streaked home in 40.0 to win that event as Heman Davenport, Jarvis White, Jessie Johnson and August combined for the triumph. In the final event of the night, August once again anchored Jaguar baton-holders to victory in the mile relay. Teaming with August for the victory were Jessie Johnson, Nathaniel Epps and Fred Hall in a time of 3:08.2.

In the high school 200 meters race,

Jassies scored 38 points to 26 for Texas Southern and 18 for Houston. Wiley College had five.
