DALLAS_____ The long jumpers and the long runners led the way over the weekend as Southwest Conference track and field men enjoyed their best collective performance of the young season.

Season's best marks were posted in eight of the 16 championship events, with long jumpers Jim MacAndrew of Texas Tech and Cecil Overstreet of Houston promising to continue a torrid competition that began at the SWC Indoor Championships last month.

Both jumpers went 25 feet 1% inch in separate meets Saturday, first time ever two SWC performers have bettered 25 feet this early in a season. MacAndrew's jump had no aiding wind, while Overstreet's was just over the allowable 4.50 mph.

Overstreet and MacAndrew were the principals in deciding the indoor championships in Fort Worth. MacAndrew, a junior transfer from Toronto, went $25-0\frac{1}{4}$ on his final jump to break the SWC indoor record. But Overstreet followed with a $25-4\frac{1}{4}$ leap to give Houston the title by $\frac{1}{2}$ -point over Baylor and $2\frac{1}{2}$ points over Texas A&M.

While these two were doing some unprecedented leaping, SWC three-milers have been busy reshaping the SWC's longest distance event. After Saturday's action, nine runners have bettered 14 minutes. Prior to this season, no more than five men had broken 14 minutes in an entire season. And only three of the nine are seniors; Rice's Marky Froelick and Texas Tech's Greg Lautenslager are freshmen and Rice's Mike Novelli and Texas' Ruben Linares are sophomores.

Elsewhere, freshman sensation Johnny (Lam) Jones of Texas is doing a good job of asserting his presence in all three short races. Jones set a school record of 20.6 seconds for the 220 around one curve and holds conference best marks of 9.21 seconds in the 100 and 46.9 in the 440.

Jones was also the anchorman as Texas turned in a 40.15 sprint relay Saturday, giving him a hand in four of the top marks in the conference through last weekend.

The quarter plot thickened even more last weekend as Baylor's Geary Harris spun a 46.95, after almost taking teammate Mark Collins a week earlier as both were timed in 47.2.

Collins, the defending 440 champ, continued to show improvement in his first campaign as a half-miler with a 1:50.10 at College Station, winning by more than ten yards. Collins now has the third fastest 440 of the season among SWC runners, even though his 45.9 last season is the sixth best ever by a conference athlete.

Arkansas' Niall O'Shaughnessy, author of an indoor 3:55.1 mile, got his first out-door competition of the season Saturday and ran a 1:50.8 half. Seven milers have already dipped under 4:10 and you can go to the bank with a list of at least eight as soon as the little Irishman runs his first outdoor four-lapper.

Among the hurdlers, A&M's Shifton Baker is tops—for this week, at least. The senior from Elgin beat all SWC competitors at Waco by finishing second in the 120 highs at 13.88, two-hundredths of a second ahead of Baylor's Davy Duncan. Then he won the 440 intermediates in 51.56, four-100ths of a second ahead of Rice's Curtis Isaiah.

And the way competition is shaping up this season in SWC track and field, that's about all the breathing room anybody can expect.
