Of the four meets, those in Lubbock, Fayesteville and Dallas were run at least part of the time under a pouring rain, while another got-together in Baton Rouge was marked by cloudless skies but high winds which more than made up for it.

So while the runners were expected to continue lowering their best times and the jumpers talked of reaching new heights, a total of only 2/ season's bests were turned in among the eight SUC units competing over the weekend, giving the weather the edge as the ovexall winner.

One change ocurred among the individual leaders as Akkansas' Niail O'Shaughnessy lowered the SWC season's best time in the 880 run to 1:49.8, more than a full second ahead of runnarup Mark Collins of Laylor who set the mark of 1:50.10 just the weekend before. O'Shaughnessy was the 1975 outdoor champson in the 880.

Elsowhere, Houston's Mark Baughman equalited his season's best as well as the SWC's top mark when he tossed the discus 175-5 at the LSU invitational in Baton Rouge.

Cornering the market on season's bests were the high jump and the mile relay competitions, both of which faced a reshuffling due to four changes in each category.

Theshean John Soloman leaped into third place in the high jump after cleaning 6-11, while Longhorns Johnny C. Johns and Rod Harvey, as well as Houston's Greg Caldwell, all hit the 6-9 figure in the rain at Dallage.

Rice's mile relay unit, composed of freshmen Keith Schnelle and Brice Gingrich, Charlie Taylor and Sanmy Waugh Tushed to a 3:12.6 clocking, second best in the SWC this measure. Houston (3:13.35), Tokes Tech (3:13.5) and Arkansas (3:16.3) also bettered their existing top times in that event.

Atkansas's Steve Pickert because the sixth competitor to go over the 200 foot much in the javelin competition, heaving the stick 218.5 for the SWC's third best mark of '77.

All pine teams will be competing this waskend as the annual Texas Relays opens its two-day run Friday in Austin.
