

King Beats Moody in 1,500 *hand*

ATHENS, Ga. — North Carolina's Ralph King, returning to his home state, ran away with the 1,500-meter run at the Spec Towns Invitational track meet at the University of Georgia Saturday.

King, from Atlanta, was clocked in 3:45.3 as he easily defeated Jeff Moody of Pembroke State. Moody was timed in 3:47.9.

North Carolina A&T's Stanley Jenkins and Troy State's Willie Pickett tied for first in the 400 meters. Both were timed in 47.57.

Western Carolina's Bobby Flemming (47.74) and North Carolina's Sam Brown (48.2) finished behind Jenkins and Pickett.

Richmond's Hillery Tuwei won the 3,000-meter steeplechase in a track record 8:42.0 and took the 5,000-meter run in 14:21.7. North Carolina's Gary Hofstetter was second in the 5,000 with a time of 14:30.0.

Pembroke State's

Charles Shipman finished second in the shot put and discus. He tossed the shot 53-8 and the discus 176-10.

Georgia freshman William Breeding was named the meet's outstanding performer. He won the 100-meter dash in a wind-aided 10.13 seconds, took the 200 in 21.04 and anchored the Bulldogs' winning 440-yard relay team.

No team scoring was kept but Baptist College of Charleston, S.C., won five events and Georgia four.
