

CAMPBELL, WORDEN SHARP

PULLMAN, Wash. — Freshman Ian Campbell and sophomore Brian Worden set Washington State indoor and Hollingbery Fieldhouse records Saturday morning as the WSU Relays opened the Inland Empire collegiate indoor track season.

Australian Campbell, in his first Cougar competition, triple jumped 52 feet, 2¾ inches while Worden, a little Californian who was just short of 17 feet in his freshman year, pole vaulted 16-7.

Honors were pretty well divided among the five schools participating, WSU winning seven of 12 events, Idaho a pair of relays. Eastern

Washington's George Hodges took the long jump while Spokane Falls student Dale Chapple, competing unattached, beat EWSC's national champion, Greg Mitchell, and WSU 7-footer Al Darneille in the high jump.

WSU freshman Mike Westlin made a solid collegiate debut in the shot put, winning at 54-5.

The "main event" of the I.E. collegiate indoor season, Idaho's second Vandal Invitational, comes next Sunday at the Kibbie Dome.
