Williams led the parade of good marks Saturday as Washington State eased through two Big Sky track opponents at Martin Stadium.

Buxton scored his usual triple victory, topped by 182-1 in the discus, and practically was upset by teammate Dwight Midles in the hammer as Midles threw a personal-best 199-2 to lose by less than five feet.

Campbell, the NCAA indoor champion, meanwhile triple jumped 53-10, his outdoor best, and Williams, a sophomore from Kent, long jumped a career-best 25-2½.

The Cougars, in a final tuneup for next weekend's Pacific-8, pulled some punches, resting distance-men Henry Rono and Joshua Kimeto and juggling a few other assignments, but still piled up 120-61 and 120-43 wins over Idaho and Weber State, respectively. Idaho whipped Weber 93-52 in their separate scoring.

But the Cougars didn't have all the good marks. Weber's Lynn Strong went 8:59.4 to lead a steeplechase 1-2 and teammate Javier Chavez beat Cougar half-miler James Brewster in the 1,500.

Idaho celebrated the 800-meter "return" of Rick Bartlett, the Big Sky champion in just his second race after injuries and a 1:50.6 winner over Mike Kosgei.

WSU got a pair of personal bests from Brian Goodman at 16-6 in the pole vault, beating teammate Brian Worden on misses, and Mike Allen at 47.2 in the 400.
