Knights Pace Track, Field Finals

 Soquel High established itself as the premier track and field school in Santa Cruz County Saturday by scoring the most total points in the first-ever SCCAL track and field championships at Memorial Field. Although the Knights hardly dominated the day's events, they did score the most points as a school, combining boys' and girls' varsity and frosh-soph divisions.

The Santa Cruz County Athletic League does not give a school point total award, but the idea is considered by many to be a good one, for it equalizes the gap between the divisions and encourages competition as a whole school rather than frosh-soph boys, varsity girls and so on.

Soquel's four teams ranked up a total of 27 points, followed by Aptos with 23, Santa Cruz with 196, San Lorenzo Valley 109, Harbor 105 and Marello Prep 64.

Soquel won the boys' varsity division, finished second in the boys' frosh-soph, third in both the girls' varsity and frosh-soph brackets.

Aptos' varsity girls' turned in an impressive performance when they edged Santa Cruz, 19-15, for frosh-soph girls laurels. Santa Cruz outpointed Soquel to win the boys' frosh-soph class.

Since the meet was the first for the new SCCAL, a total of 98 meet records fell.

One athlete who competed Saturday will have three years to break her already-outstanding meet records. Aptos High's Kelly Osterkamp held off a

freshman Nancy Hurck turned in first place efforts in the 800 (2:18.7) and mile (5:12.7), as well as two relay legs.

Hurck is simply one of the best female middle distance runners in California, regardless of age. Nancy's only problem is following her own act for she has won a national title in the next three track seasons. Santa Cruz sprinter Andre Wilkes also had a good day, winning the 100 and 200-yard dashes in a strong breeze.

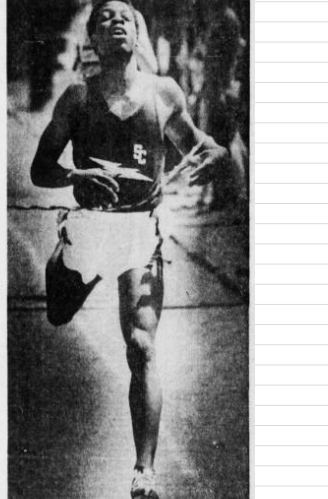

SCCAL Record Falls At Track-Field Trials

Six athletes ran to a pair of first place finishes and another set a Santa Cruz County Athletic League record at the SCCAL track trials Wednesday afternoon at Santa Cruz High's Memorial Field.

Soquel's Greg Munoz churned to a 40.6 timing in the boys' varsity 300 low hurdles to set a new SCCAL record by just two-tenths of a second, eclipsing the old mark of 40.8 held by teammate Jim Verdugo.

Santa Cruz Bob Sanders tied his own SCCAL mark in the frosh-soph 70 high hurdles with a 9.2 time, which is also the best time in the Region IV to date.

Fellow Santa Cruzan Andre Wilkes sped to a 9.9 100 time for one of his two firsts, the other of which came in the 220 where he posted a 24.4.

Aptos' Bob Schindler took first in the second heat of the 220 at 23.3 and also crossed the

line ahead of the pack in the first heat of the 440 at 52.6.

Harbor High's Lezli Peterson, who owns the top SCCAL mark in the 100, 220 and 440 — came through with firsts in both the 100 (11.7) and 220 (26.8), neither of which through broke her own standards.

Santa Cruz' Sal Locatelli prevailed in the 100 (10.7) and 220 (24.9) in the boys' frosh-soph competition, while fellow Cardinal Sharon Hightower finished first in the girls' frosh-soph 100 (12.2) and 220 (29.1).

Soquel High's Robert East rounded the list of six double winners with a 24.1 clocking in the boys' frosh-soph 220 and a 55.7 in the 440.

The finals are slated for Saturday at Santa Cruz High's Memorial Field, with the field events commencing at 10 a.m. and the running action starting

an hour later at 11 a.m.

Admission to the finals is \$1 for adults and 50 cents for students and children.

The top three finishers in each heat — there were two heats for every event — advance to Saturday's finals. Complete results of all running event qualifiers are listed below with their times.
