Track is like fishing: The big ones are down deep.

And there's no doubt that Los Altos High has the deepest track squad in the Santa Clara Valley Athletic League, coming from behind to win league championship Saturday at Foothill College.

Although Cubberley won five races and Los Altos only one, the Knights rallied to win four field events and picked up many additional points by consistently placing among the top six to wear the SCVAL track crown again.

Los Altos finished with 112 points to outdistance threats Cubberley (90) and Buchser (83) for its 18th SCVAL title in the school's 21 years.

Los Altos won the girls' varsity

division with 88 points to finish ahead of Wilcox (63) and Gunn (54).

In the boys' frosh-soph competition, Mountain View won the SCVAL championship with 102 points in an impressive showing of young talent.

The Knights won the varsity title the hard way.

Cubberley swept through the field early in the meet as junior Bill Green won the 100-yard dash, 220 and 440 to accompany Cougar victories in the 440 relay and one by Terry Smith in the 330 low hurdles.

Green was at his best in the 440, clocking a 47.6, the top time in the Central Coast Section this year and the second best in the state. He won the 100 in 9.7 and nipped Craig Co-

peland at the wire in the 220 with a 22.9.

In the 220, however, Green slowed considerably around the final turn and complained of a deep hip pain following the race. He was taken to the hospital for tests, according to Cubberley coach Jack Young.

Cubberley was especially impressive in the 330 low hurdles, where Smith along with Jeff and James Moss finished one-two-three.

It lifted Cubberley to an early margin of 66-45 over Los Altos.

But Cubberley's Achilles heel is the field events and the Knights made it especially painful.

Los Altos' Fred Grolle doubled by taking the long jump (22-6½) and triple jump (46-6), Steve Alex-

# Time the DAAL field

Some people enjoy the challenge of shooting the rapids by themselves. Others savor the prospect of running alone through Death Valley.

And others want to climb the highest mountains. They do it for the challenge. They do it because it is there.

Dave Avila of Cupertino High faced that same challenge at the De Anza Athletic League track and field finals Friday at Fremont High.

Avila wanted to see if he could win a grueling triple, never before accomplished in the league meet. He wanted to win the 880, mile and two-mile, which is something like the Triple Crown of track and field.

To heap adversity upon his challenge, Avila had to overcome a week of being ill. And he did.

Avila went out and won the 880 in 1:59.7, took the mile in 4:24.9 and returned to capture the two-mile in 9:46.8 to account for 30 points and highlight Cupertino's successful defense of its league title.

The Pioneers finished with 132 points to overwhelm runnerup Fremont, which had 90, and third-place Sunnyvale which ended with 84½.

Both the Indians and Jets had expected to give Cupertino a run for the title, but it turned out to just a one-horse race.

"It was a really scary situation

for Dave," said Cupertino coach Norm Eliason, "because he hadn't done it. We didn't plan on it earlier, but he said he wanted to try."

Earlier in the week, Avila had kidded around about last year's four individual victories by teammate Steve Guthrie. He figured if Guthrie could win four, then he could capture three events. And even though the times were slower than his season bests, Avila proved he could do it.

Guthrie, of course, kept the pressure on by winning three more races. The senior hurdler won a big 100-yard dash in 9.9, took the 120 high hurdles in 14.5 despite hitting seven barriers and sped to a season-best of 38.2 in the 330 lows.

Jack Crendon added a victory in the 440 in a season-best 50.6 and anchored the triumphant mile relay team to more than make up for some deficiencies in the field events.

While Cupertino dominated the victory stand, Fremont's 440 relay team and Ross McAlexander of Monta Vista came through with meet records.

The Indians' sprint quartet stepped off a school and meet record 43.2 in upsetting Cupertino and taking over the No. 3 position in the Central Coast Section rankings.

McAlexander once again scaled the heights and took over the second spot on the CCS list in the pole vault with a school and meet mark of 15-6½. His missed three attempts at 15-9.

While McAlexander's triumph came as no surprise, Jim Corsini of Sunnyvale did surprise a lot of people by improving his best vault mark by more than a foot in establishing a school record of 14-3 in taking third.

There were few surprises in the girls' division Friday as favored Lynbrook lived up to its role by demolishing the field easily.

Versatile Kris Costello of Lynbrook won three individual events and ran a leg on the Vikings' 440 relay team which clocked a CCS best of 48.2. She also won the 220, 110 low hurdles and long jump.

Surprisingly enough, none of Costello's victories produced meet records. There were six established, three going to her teammates.

The top five finishers in each event now advance to next Saturday's Region II meet at College of San Mateo.

# Green sizzles at track trials

The Santa Clara Valley Athletic League track and field finals a week from today is shaping up to be a three-team affair.

Perennial champion Los Altos is joined in this year's race for the league and overall championship by Cubberley and Buchser. All three qualified just about all of their top people during Friday's trials at Foothill College.

It was a day of strong winds, which helped runners and jumpers accordingly to some of the best marks, albeit wind-aided, in the Central Coast Section.

Bill Green of Cubberley turned-in extremely fast times by qualifying first in the 100 at 9.6 and 220 at 21.4. Both would be the best in the CCS if not for the blustery winds.

Green also clocked a non-windy 48.0, lowering his previous CCS best by eight tenths. The Cougars' 440 relay team also utilized the talents of the junior sprint sensation in clocking the fastest qualifying time of 43.2, the team's season best.

Fred Boyer of Cubberley had the No. 1 mile time with a lifetime best of 4:23 while teammate Jeff Moss returned from a hamstring injury to lead the 330 low hurdle field in 39.1.

The fast times weren't allotted to just Cubberley, however, as Awalt's Kobert Smith zipped to a 1:57.0 in the 880 and a 4:24 in the mile. Teammate Rick Weyers paced the shot and discus qualifiers with bests of 56-0 and 151-0, respectively.

Los Altos also qualified most of its top performers in getting ready to defend its league crown. Fred Grolle led the horizontal jumpers with bests of 22-6 in the long and 45-0 in the triple jump.

Craig Copeland zipped to a lifetime bests of 22.4 in the 220 and 50.9 in the 440, but Alan Goes failed to make the 880 field after battling the effects of mononucleosis the past 10 days. Goes did make the 330 low hurdle field and will also run on the Los Altos relay squads.
