## Knight spikes control finals

Hillsdale High's track team made a shambles of the Mid-Peninsula League track finals Thursday at Sky-

line College.

The Knights won both the girls' and boys' division by healthy margins. Hillsdale had 153 to win the boys' over Aragon's 129. Hillsdale's girls scored 114½ to San Mateo's 75.

The Knights' slightly injured star, John Zukowsky, was the difference. He won three events, taking both hurdles and the long jump. He clocked a windy 14.4 in taking the high hurdles over teammate Reggie Hawkins (14.5).

Zukowsky came back to ease to a win in 39.2 in the low hurdles. Then he long jumped a season-best of 21-6 to take that event. The Knights won both relays, and went 2-3 in the 100 meters and 1-2 in the 200 meters.

Dave Marson of Mills was a double winner, taking the 800 meters in 1:58.4 (narrowly edging Pete Ryner of Aragon) and the 1600 meters in 4:33.4.

Aragon's Brian Bauter swept the weights, throwing the shot 52-1 and the discus a season-best of 157-7. Crestmoor's Mark Wilcox, just a junior, heaved the discus 156-1 for second place.

Mark Besse of Aragon won the high jump with a season-best of 6-5, and Hillsdale sophomore Mike Green won the 400 meters in 51.5.

San Mateo and Hillsdale dominated the girls' division. The Bearcats won four events and Hillsdale took five. The Bearcats have little depth, but have some splendid individuals, led by sprinter Julie Middleton.

Middleton took the 100 meters in a windy 12.0 and the 200 meters in 25.6. She also ran on the winning 400 meter relay team, which clocked 49.9.

Right behind Middleton in both of the sprints was teammate Val Ford. She clocked a 12.26 and a 25.73 for two second places, and then eased to a win in the 400 meters. She also ran on the relay team.

Wendy Allen of Hillsdale took a very competitive 800 meters in 2:22.0, and teammate Brenda Brewer long jumped a season-best, albeit windy, 17-4.

Julie Herron of Hillsdale won the 100 low hurdles in 15.5, and was second in the 300 low hurdles in 49.55, just behind teammate Becky

Corley (49.50). Nicole Lucey of Burlingame was third in the 300's at 50.0.

Sue Beatty of Aragon won a close race in the 3200 meters (11:49.2), and Monika Zieschang took the 1600 meters for Capuchino in 5:37.7. Carol Shoaff took the discus at 100-01/2.

The top four placers in each of the three divisions advance to the Region I Meet at Hillsdale next week. Trials are on Tuesday with the finals slated for Thursday.

# Falcs' Thompson stars in trials

Crestmoor High's Jim Thompson had an up-and-down year in track.

He started off fast, posting some fine early-season times. But about midway through the season, he broke a collarbone and that set back his schedule.

But if Tuesday's Mid-Peninsula League track trials at Skyline college are any indication, Thompson may be just starting to peak. He posted the top times in both the 100 and 200 meters, and had the third-fastest time in the 400 meters.

Hillsdale's Reggie Hawkins had the top qualifying time in the high hurdles at 14.5, with slightly injured teammate John Zukowsky already seeded into the finals in both the highs and lows. Hillsdale's Bill Fobbs topped the trials in the 300 lows.

Dave Marson of Mills was first in the 800 meters, clocking an easy 2:00.8. his sophomore teammate Dan Katches had the top mark of the whole day on the frosh-soph level. He won the discus at 165-5, the seventh best mark in the Central Coast Section this year.

San Mateo's Julie Middleton paced

the girls' qualifying. She topped the field in the 100 and 200 meters with teammate Val Ford second in both races. Ford has the top 400 meter time also.

Barbara Gaenslen of Mills posted a fine 2;25.5 in the 800 meters for the top time and two Hillsdale girls, Julie Herron and Becky Corley, paced the hurdle qualifying.
