Hillsdale near title in Region I track

While the rest of the participants in Thursday's Central Coast Section Region I prep track and field finals were moaning about the roaring winds whipping across the Hillsdale High field, Serramonte High triple jumper Donald Franks was making the best of it.

With the aid of a 20-mph-plus wind (which gusted to more than 40 mph), Franks recorded probably the premier mark of the meet with a 47-3 triple jump to take first place in that event.

With the exception of Westmoor weightperson Carolyn Perkins, who uncorked a CCS best 141-6 discus throw, the gusty gales hampered most of the remaining marks.

South City sprinting star Carl Montgomery didn't get a chance to show how well he could have weathered the winds. In a surprise move, Montgomery forfeited his chances at a possible state meet championship. Montgomery hung up his track spikes for the remainder of the season due to a hamstring pull.

"We worked hard to get that leg back in shape," said Montgomery's coach, Marv Ashby. "I thought he was all set to go. But he says he's not well enough to run, and I guess he knows best."

The gales were bad enough to postpone the varsity pole vault competition until Saturday morning at College of San Mateo.

So although Hillsdale finished the meet in first place with 60½ points, the official varsity team championship is still up in the air. Aragon is currently in second place with 53 points, and Serramonte is third with 52.

"I surprised myself," said Franks, whose best triple jump entering the meet was 45-7. "I was just hoping to qualify with at least 46-0."

"I kept scratching on my earlier jumps because I was dragging my foot," said Franks. "But on my last attempt I got off a good jump, and I could feel the wind carry me."

Hillsdale hurdler John Zukowsky didn't need any help in carrying himself to an easy win in the 330-yard race. Zukowsky's time of 39.4 was not overly impressive, but the ease with which he won was.

Zukowsky also helped Hillsdale capture the mile relay with a strong second-leg effort. It was the first time Zukowsky had run on the mile relay, but he looked like he had been doing it all his life.

Zukowsky's bid for a perfect day had been spoiled in the opening event of the meet.

Jefferson's Robert Thompson held off the hard-charging Zukowsky in the 120-yard low hurdles race in a winning time of 14.39. Zukowsky was clocked in 14.4.

"I got a good start, one of my best ever," said Thompson. "I saw him coming out of the corner of my eye, and I was worried for a second. But I feel I could've even run faster than I did today. I'm going to have to run more like 13.9 to win the CCS, but on that track I think I can do it."

Aragon weightman Brian Bauter scored an upset in the discus throw over Westmoor's Henry Hall, who owns the best mark in the CCS (176-6). Bauter won the event with a 156-8 throw, and also won the shot put at 51-11.

"My practice throws and trial throws were terrible," said Bauter. "The wind was terrible. It was throwing me sideways in the shot put ring. I was worried the whole time that I might not even qualify."

"I was just getting mad," said the 215-pound junior. "But it helps pump me up when I get mad. I said to myself, I've got to do it. I've been to CCS the last two years, and I didn't want to blow it this year."

Bauter won the frosh-soph CCS championship in the shot put as a freshman, and was third last year.

Hall qualified with a sub-par 150-8 third-place finish in the discus, but felt fortunate, under the circumstances, to do that well.

"I'm left-handed, so I was the only one throwing into the wind," said Hall. "I was fighting it all the way, so all I wanted to do was qualify. But next week in the CCS meet, there won't be any wind down there. I'll throw down there. I'm going to throw at least 170."

San Mateo edged rival Hillsdale 67-66 for the girls' title. Bearcat Julie Middleton was one of the main reasons.

Middleton won the 100-meter dash, won the 220-yard dash and ran

on San Mateo's victorious 440 relay team. Quite an accomplishment for a sophomore.

"I wanted the 100 race bad," said Middleton. "But the 220 is really my favorite event. I started a little slow in the 220, and I didn't feel good going into the first turn. I was trying to drive and pump, but the wind was holding me back."

Westmoor missed out on the frosh-soph championship by a scant half point.
