SLV, Aptos Capture Team Championships

SALINAS — The San Lorenzo Valley Cougars and the Aptos Mariners represented the Santa Cruz County Athletic League in style Saturday at Hartnell College, capturing the girls' varsity and boys' frosh-soph Region IV track championships, respectively.

The two Region IV crowns are the first ever for both schools. North Salinas won the boys' varsity title over second-place Seaside.

In all, close to 30 SOCAL competitors finished in the top three in their respective events, qualifying them for the Central Coast Section Championships Friday at San Jose City College.

San Lorenzo, which garnered five Region IV events, was led by Cathy Dee and Susan Smith, who accounted for 53 of their team's 84 total points.

Smith won the 800-meters in a school record 2:18.2 over undefeated Tiffany Clay of Salinas, then added another victory in the 400 with a school record 59.0. Smith topped her day by anchoring the winning Cougar 1600-meter relay team to a school record 4:04.9.

Dee captured the 100 and 200-meters in 12.3 (tying the school record) and 23.2 (new school record), respectively. Dee was second in the long jump in yet another school record 16-11 while running the first leg of

the 1600-meter relay team. Other members of the 1600-meter relay team were Dea Mason and Kari Pratt.

SLV's Patty McGuire was third in the shot put and second in the discus, while teammates Angela Paradise and Deena Pearson were third in the hurdles and 1600-meter run, respectively.

The Aptos frosh-soph trailed by three points going into the final event, but Jeff Powell finished third in the pole vault for six points to boost the Mariners to the victory.

Bill Shirley won two Region IV events, the 200 and the 600-meter dashes. Teammate Darryl Boral won the low hurdles in a school record 40.2 and Aptos won the 1600-meter relay easily over Seaside.

In the boys' varsity, Bob Sanders of Santa Cruz was the only local winner in the high hurdles and also qualified for the CCS with a third in the jowes.

Ken Kirsch of Aptos was second in the 800-meters as was John Swedlund of SLV in the shot put.

Greg Lindner broke the oldest standing Valley track and field record when he finished fourth in the discus with a toss of 165-2, shattering the old mark of 158-6 set by Clark Fullerton in 1964.

Also in girls' varsity, Marianne Eck and Kim Horn of Soquel finished one-two in the hurdles, while teammate Kristi Jacobson was third in the 3200-meters.

Molly Mayall was Harbor's lone qualifier with a second-place showing in the high jump.

Both Hampton of Aptos was second in the 3200 in front of Jacobson with an 11:42.8 clocking.

In the boys' frosh-soph, Scott Porter of SLV set a new school record with his 4:37.7 as he won the 1600-meters.

John Vitug of Santa Cruz qualified for two CCS berths with third-place finishes in the high and low hurdles.
