

CCS frosh-soph competition is eliminated

SAN JOSE — As expected, the Central Coast Section Board of Managers Thursday approved the elimination of all sectional competition on the frosh-soph level, effective this fall.

The CCS had sponsored frosh-soph meets in boys' and girls' swimming, boys' cross country and boys' track.

Elimination of the frosh-soph division was strongly opposed by many track and swim coaches.

"I don't feel we can defend having frosh-soph competition for boys and not for girls in some sports, or having frosh-soph in individual sports but not in team sports," board chairman Wil Concklin said during the meeting at

the San Jose Elks Club. "So we have to either add to or restrict programs. And adding girls' frosh-soph to a section meet, for example, would be impractical."

Scheduled appeals by the De Anza and South Peninsula athletic leagues concerning the recent section-wide realignment were postponed.
