Brown again sets triple jump record

Woodside High School's Wendy Brown apparently has not peaked yet because the 5-foot-11 senior continues to improve.

Brown, the two-time defending state champion in the triple jump, won that event Saturday in the 16th annual Gilroy Invitational track meet by leaping 42-3½ — a national high school girls' record.

Brown, who also finished third in the state in the long jump last year after winning the state title in that event in 1982, set two other meet records Saturday at sun-baked Gilroy High. Brown won the long jump at 20-3 and also took the high jump at 6-0, one inch below the Central Coast Section record she set in a Peninsula Athletic League meet March 29.

Brown's 42-3½ was only one foot and one-half inch off the women's world record, set Saturday by the University of Texas' Terri Turner, who leaped 43-4 at the LSU Invitational in Baton Rouge, La.

No wind gauge was used, but Brown's triple jump is expected to be recognized as a national record because of Saturday's hot weather and lack of wind.

Brown's previous life best in the triple jump was a wind-aided 41-11½, which she achieved March 31 in the first Foothill College-St. Francis High School Track and Field Carnival at Foothill College.

Other Peninsula girls who did well included Woodside sophomore LaShun Peters, who won the 200 meters in 25.58 seconds, and Homestead's Margaret Ruden, who took

the 300 hurdles in 46.06. In addition, St. Francis' girls set a meet record by winning the mile relay in 4:00.45.

In the boys' competition, Hillsdale's Roger Grimes won the long jump at 22-11¾, Woodside's Andre Taylor took the 400 in 49.83 and Bellarmine's Don Castle won the 300 intermediate hurdles in 39.78. Los Altos junior Tyler Burke placed second to Castle in 39.79.

St. Francis' Michael Davidson ran an impressive anchor in the boys' mile relay, running a 47.1 to overcome a 25-meter deficit and win the race.

In an Olympic development meet Saturday at Los Angeles State, Mills High's Leslie Maxie ran 58.35 to finish third in the women's 400-meter hurdles. Maxie, who ran 57.52 (a national high school record) eight days ago in Arizona, had some difficulty with two of the 10 hurdles this time.

Senior right-hander Rick Witt pitched a five-hitter and Brad Pfaff drove in three runs Saturday as Monta Vista beat Silver Creek at San Jose's Gunderson High, 9-3, in a first-round game in the annual Lions' Tournament.

Witt pitched his first complete game since he was ill with the chicken pox recently.

Tom McGovern, Dan Gossett and

Pfaff each got two of Monta Vista's 12 hits off three pitchers. Pfaff hit a two-run double in the third inning and a run-scoring single in the fifth. McGovern doubled twice.

In the 10th annual Westmont Invitational diving meet at Westmont High in Campbell, Carlmont senior Rex Schmidt finished third with 340.05 points for 11 dives.

Los Gatos' John McClene and David Frisby placed one-two.

Three De Anza Athletic League divers placed four-five-six. Lynbrook's Cory Cresman finished fourth with 324.30 points, followed by Saratoga's David Moir and Al Krause with 320.35 and 314.00 points.
