Aragon spikes win 3-2-84

SAN MATEO — Aragon High's track team opened its non-league season by winning a quadrangular meet Thursday at College of San Mateo.

The Dons totaled 96 points to 68 for Half Moon Bay, 57 for Jefferson and 6 1/2 for a partial Serra team.

Aragon also won the girls' meet with 67 points over Jefferson (59) and Half Moon Bay (49).

Don Beck led the way for Aragon with two hurdles wins, including a 42.2 over the new 300-meter intermediate hurdles.

This year, instead of the boys' running low hurdles, over 300 meters, they'll run over intermediates.

Luann Campbell paced Aragon's girls to victory. She won both the long jump and triple jump with respectable marks, ran a leg on the winning 400 meter relay team (which clocked a fine 50.7), and was second in the long jump.

Winning isn't everything — Mike Guisto

DALY CITY — Mike Guisto has reached a point in his brilliant prep running career where winning isn't everything. He's more interested in running to his utmost ability.

Then he's satisfied.

The San Mateo High senior finished third in the high school boys' 3000 meter run at the Foot Locker Track Classic Friday night at the Cow Palace, yet showed few physical signs of disappointment.

Guisto, who won the Kinney national cross-country championships, was elated when Kinney executives walked by and congratulated him for his effort. One lady said, "We were all pulling for you."

Guisto and the rest of the field, including Mills' Chris Becerra and Capuchino's Paul Ghidossi, watched helplessly as Castro Valley's Calvin Gaziano won easily with a meet record 8:25.8 mark.

Although Guisto also broke the previous record, set in 1981 by Independence's Jesse Torres at 8:31.5, the San Mateo athlete settled for third place, in 8:30.9, behind Gaziano and Roman Gomez of Belmont High in Los Angeles.

"What separates me from Gaziano was that he felt that he had to go to his full potential to win the race," Guisto said. "I go all out, but winning isn't the most important thing. I do have my serious moments."

Becerra, who finished fifth at 8:39.5, jumped to an early lead in the 20-lap event. He paced the group for five laps before Guisto, Gaziano, Gomez and Chris Craig of Leigh in San Jose suddenly arrived at the front.

Guisto immediately took the lead.

"We thought there was too much screwing around near the back of the pack," Guisto said. "We were getting backed in and out of the lanes by the slower runners."

When the lagging runners didn't pull over to let the front-runners slide by, the eventual leaders took the initiative.

Guisto maintained the lead until the final two laps, when Gaziano made a mockery of the previously close battle.

Guisto, who won the Central Coast Section cross-country title in the fall, went on to place third in the

Kinney western regionals, losing to Gaziano. However, the 5-9 Guisto bounced back to beat Gaziano and others in the national finals.

The Peninsula Athletic League should have an exciting year in the distance portion of the track and field season. Guisto, combined with Becerra and Ghidossi, should make for entertaining battles in the mile and two-mile.

The PAL trio have engaged in a three-way confrontation for four years, each one taking a turn in the spotlight.

"This should be a good track season," Guisto said. "Becerra outclassed me my freshman year, then Ghidossi outclassed me my sophomore year. Then I came on last year, and have stayed there."

Guisto said that facing such quality league competition helped him become the talented runner he is.

"I worked hard my junior year because I wanted to be up with those guys. I aimed at getting into their class."

The Foster City resident has escalated a class.

He plans to enroll at the University of Arizona "mainly because of cross-country, track and academics." He had been considering Nebraska and UCLA, but a trip to Tucson two weeks ago convinced him that was where he wanted to go.

In other action involving local preps, Westmoor's Sabrina Han finished second in the girls' high school 3000 meters with a 10:19.7, 25 seconds behind Shannon Clark of Mountain View. Terra Nova's Lori Wilson placed sixth at 10:34.4.

The Westmoor boy's 8 x 150 meter relay team took third place in 2:27.8, placing behind Pittsburg High and Grant High of Sacramento.

LaShun Peters of Woodside captured the high school girls' 55 meter run in 7.0. Ramon Tisdale of Westmoor won the high school boys' long jump, leaping 22-3/4.

Former Capuchino basketball coach Jimmy Johnson, who remains in annual running competition, placed second in the Masters 55 meter run for men 60 years old and up. Johnson had a 7.8 time, second to former Stanford track coach Payton Jordan.

Leland boys, girls run to wins

Leland and Gunderson take pride in their track programs.

They have a great rivalry in any athletic endeavor, but in track the outcome of their meets usually determines the Santa Teresa Athletic League championship.

No doubt it did Friday although it was a league opener for both. And Leland was a double winner, its boys team defeating Gunderson 70-56 and its girls winning 65-62.

Both teams must meet Willow Glen, Pioneer, Lincoln and San Jose, but none figure to have the balance or depth to challenge Leland or Gunderson. And the dual-meet standings determine the championship.

One sensed a great meet was in store when Leland coach Don Bell displayed his dopesheet that showed Leland's boys leading by three points going into the mile relay.

"There is no clear-cut edge," Bell said. "Who knows about the frosh-soph meet, but you can count on it going to the mile relay in all three meets."

Gunderson coach Rudy Montenegro agreed with Bell's assessment.

"Some of the best athletes in the CCS are in this meet," Montenegro said, "but the key people will be those who get those place points you might not expect."

The coaches were right on all counts although the Leland boys clinched a victory one event before the mile relay, when Brian Kellen cleared 6-foot-6 to win the high jump. The Chargers also won the mile relay.

With Gunderson going 1-2 in the triple jump, the Leland girls knew they had to win the mile relay to win the meet. They did.

The frosh-soph teams went into the mile relay deadlocked 65-65. Gunderson won the relay to win the meet 70-65.

"There were lots of heroes in the boys meet," Bell said, "but Eric Sandall probably made the difference for us."

"We had two sprinters out with injuries so we moved up some sophomores. We didn't expect Eric to win the 220, but he did. And that came at a time when I thought we would win or lose the meet."

"(John) Hollenbeck and (Bill) Blodgett are two sophs who won events and the three of them teamed with junior Scott Sumwalt to win the mile relay."

Cindy Rosenberg, Nancy Grochowski, Jennifer Crockett and Laurel Lammle teamed up to win the mile relay and the meet for the Leland girls.

Nancy Rice aided the Leland cause with a school-record 123-9 to win the discus.

Leland won despite outstanding efforts by Gunderson's Sherrie Olson, who won four events — 100-meter low hurdles (16.4), high jump (4-10), long jump (16-3) and triple jump (34-10). Laurie Chapman and Deena Adams also went 1-2 in the mile and two mile ahead of

Leland's Jeannette DeMoss in hotly contested races.

In addition to the high jump, Kellen won the triple jump with a CCS season best of 46-1 and the long jump with a 20-2 leap into a strong wind.

Gunderson's James Green registered a distance triple, winning the 880 (2:01.1), mile (4:41.7) and two mile (10:07.1) plus a 52.6 anchor leg on the mile relay.
