Houston's shot is long enough

Fred Houston's first priority is to qualify for the state meet. His second is to reach his preseason goal of 65 feet in the shot put.

The Willow Glen senior is zeroing in on the first and is not as far away as it may appear from

reaching the second.

"Competing in the state meet has always been a dream," Houston said Friday night after winning Region II competition at San Jose City College. "I'm not there yet and no one will know for sure for at least two more weekends."

The victory Friday qualified the 6-foot-2, 250-pounder for the Central Coast Section finals next Fri-

day night at SJCC.

Houston won Region II laurels with a 59-61/2 heave, well ahead of runnerup Jack Mohr of Los Altos. who did 55-11/2. Roger Creedon of Cupertino was next at 54-8% and Eric Volta of Santa Clara claimed the fourth qualifying spot at 53-7%

"These same people, along with Troy Sheets (Del Mar), will challenge next week," Houston said. "I thought I would do better today because I had a good week of practice.

"I'm disappointed, but I'm really not that far away from a 65-foot throw."

His best of the season is 60-61/2 and that may appear a long way from his goal to a casual observer.

Willow Glen weight coach Matt Kiesle agrees with Houston.

"There is a lot be can do to improve himself technically." Kiesle said. "He's got a quick arm but he needs to work on his speed across the ring.

"His footwork is kind of jerky. but technically speaking, he's not far from putting everything

together."

Houston does not want to look too far ahead, but he's well aware of the competition that will appear in the state meet June 2 at the Los Angeles Coliseum.

One of them is destined to be Brian Blutreich of Capistrano Valley High School in Mission Viejo, a junior who has done 68-41/4.

Blutreich got off the fourth best toss in California high school history after a previous best of 64-41/4.

Blutreich and at least two others have gone past 64-6 but they are all in the Southern California Region. Houston is No. 1 in Northern California.

"I'm not overlooking anyone," Houston said. "I respect every

opponent.

"Some of the people right here are not that far away technically from improving by five to six feet in a given meet."

Houston has given up the discus to concentrate on the shot put the rest of the season and may give up football to concentrate on track.

"I've been picked to play in the Santa Clara County All-Star football game," Houston said. "That may be my last football game.

"I might go to UC-Berkeley. They have talked to me and I am

interested."

Houston was an All-Santa Teresa League performer as a defensive lineman last fall but prefers to play offensive guard.

Houston was not the only stand-

out in the Region II meet.

Louie Fortman of Milpitas stamped himself as a threat in the 100- and 400-meter dashes with impressive efforts.

He won the 100 in 10.8 but was more spectacular in the 400, breez-

ing home in 48.6

"If I keep this up I might convince myself I belong in the race," Fortman said after the 400.

He spent most of the season running the 100 and 200 and only recently came on the scene in the 400. He may prove a tough challenger for defending CCS champion Mike Davidson of St. Francis. who won the Region I 400 in San Mateo and also helped the Lancers win the 400 and 1,600 meter relays.

Among the standout performers in the girls' Region II meet was Karen Lawson of St. Francis, a freshman who long jumped 19-41/2. That is the sixth best on the all-time CCS list but probably will not be recognized because of an aiding wind.

Lawson also won the 100 in 12.4.
