DeMartini's Throws Get Farther

SAN JOSE — The Bellarmine Jellies scored a West Catholic Athletic League dual meet victory over St. Ignatius, 94.5-41.5, but the Wildcats' Chris DeMartini continues to impress with his shot put and discus performances.

DeMartini extended his school record and state-leading discus mark with a throw of 192 feet, 5 inches.

In the shot put, DeMartini extended his personal best with a 41-foot, 1/2-inch throw, which is second best in the state this season.

Josiah Larkin recorded a personal best effort of 45 feet in the triple jump for St. Ignatius.

In the frosh/soph competition, Wildcat freshman Brad Hanson broke the SI freshman mile record with a time of 4:35.2, and then broke his own freshman 2-mile record with a time of 9:48.6.

The previous freshman mile record of 4:37.2, was set in 1966 by Klaus Hoffman.

St. Ignatius is 3-1 in WCAL dual meets, and Bellarmine is 3-0.
