Felton Charles' life in fast lane

DALY CITY — There was a time not too long ago that Felton Charles wouldn't win the race he entered.

It was back in sixth grade at Ben Franklin Junior High in Daly City when Charles would be beaten by faster teammates.

How the "times" have changed, pardon the pun.

Charles has won just about every race he entered. Last week at the Rio Linda Invitational, he set meet records in the 200 (21.8), and 400 (49.7). A few days later, Charles won the 400 at the Oakland Invitational, lowering his Central Coast Section-best in the time to 49.12 in the process.

For this, Charles has been named The Times Male Athlete of the Week.

Just a sophomore, Charles is already close to leaving his name in the Westmoor track and field record book. He trails the late Kerry Threats in both the 200 (21.6) and 400 (47.0). Threats' 200 mark, set

in 1984, could be by his soon. The 400 record, also set in 1984, could take a little time.

In addition to his feats on the track, Charles also ranks in the CCS in the high jump and long jump. The only time he did the high jump, he cleared 6-6.

"I just want to leave my mark everywhere," Charles said.

That includes, Westmoor, the CCS, the state, as well as every track meet he participates.

Not bad when one considers that after losing a few races in the sixth grade, Charles almost gave up track and field. It wasn't that he lacked the talent.

The losses started to get to a point where he flat out gave up on track. But after a talk with his father, Charles was back, working to get better.

Charles didn't make his mark until the eighth grade when he won at a Jessie Owens meet. Coaches from the Senators Track Club, based out of San Francisco and Daly City, saw this and asked Charles to join the

team. The rest is history.

His new goals include a return trip to the CIF State Meet in June. This time he would like to do better. Last year, he arrived with a good mark. But his first big meet resulted in jitters.

"I wasn't used to running in front of 10,000 people," Charles said. "Now I am."

He is also used to running with top level competition. At Saturday's meet, he ran stride for stride with Ali Evans of Vallejo High. Evans is a three-time qualifier for the state meet, and bound for Washington State in the fall.

"He is a very level-headed kid," said Westmoor coach Ron DiMagio. "Considering all the publicity, he isn't cocky."
