Arcadia/Foot Locker Invitational

Starting off the National Outdoor season with over 2000 athletes during the day from over fifteen states, the greater Los Angeles area Arcadia/Foot Locker Invitational provided some strong marks for athletes to shoot at for the remainder of the spring. Seventeen event winners recorded the top mark in the nation thus far this spring, with eleven others recording the second best mark so far in the country on a calm, warm Southern California evening before a sell-out crowd of 8000. The meet, which featured a number of exciting events and athletes that the crowd responded to in a very animated manner, may have been the best in the twenty-eight year history of the meet, with almost every event featuring something truly special.

Highlighting the entire meet was Michael Granville, with the two-time National High School Indoor Athlete of the Year, hot off setting a National Indoor 800m record of 1:50.55, continuing right into the outdoor season. Granville would here face a top 800 meter field here, with Aaron Richburg running 1:48.4 on a sprint medley relay leg the previous weekend to take down soph Obie Moore (1:51) the week previous, with the Foot Locker race set up with that challenge to Granville. Facing the above duo and a number of others under 1:54.0, Michael did not wait around for long, charging out at 24.5-51.8, daring the competition to mount a contest. Obie Moore was boxed early on, with Richburg making an effort down the backstretch to establish contact, but no one really ever caught up with the flying Granville,

who recorded a 1:20.2 at the 600 on the way to an amazing 1:47.96 clocking, making him the #4 prep performer ever in the event and setting a new National Junior Class record (breaking another John Marshall record, as he did with the 1:50.55 indoors). Richburg finished in 1:49.12 and Moore 1:49.16 (second fastest soph time ever), with seventh place 1:52.17 in the quick field. Michael was named Athlete of the Meet with everyone left aghast at his impressive effort.

On the Girls' side La Shonda Christopher cranked a great Triple Jump series (41-04.5, 41-04.5, 41-10.5, 39-3.5, f, topped by a 42-1.25 (wind +.45), among the top dozen prep efforts of all-time in dominating that competition by over four feet! In the Long Jump, Christopher would meet rivals Pam Simpson, the winner at the National Scholastic Indoor, and Jernae Wright, who took the competition between the trio at the Simplot Indoor Games. Christopher led early on in the competition, leaping 19-7.5, 19-10, and 19-11.25, with Simpson a 19-5.5 opener and Wright a 19-5.5 second effort and two monster 21-foot fouls. Attention was drawn to the event on the final efforts, with Wright responding with a monster 20-09.75 effort, that Christopher met with a 20-0.5 jump. Wright's effort makes her the equal #12 all-time prep performer ever, an effort that took down Marion Jones' 20-9.25 Meet Record. Christopher narrowly won the Athlete of the Meet balloting.

Other stars abounded! Deworski Odom, hot off National Records in the 55 Meter and 60 Meter High Hurdles, and the 60 Meter Dash indoors, came to

town and put on a show in the 100 and the 110 Highs. The World Junior Championship runner-up in the 100 meters at 10.26, the Philadelphia star almost false-started, and was leaning back into the blocks when the gun fired for the sprint event. The powerful, prancing Odom blasted back and past the field to a 10.44 (0 wind) clocking, with Marques Holiwell keeping him honest with a 10.50 in second. A bad ankle for Bryan Howard had spoiled a great match-up in this event, with Odom's power leaving spectators gasping. Holiwell returned in the 200 to record a very impressive nation-leading 21.34 (-.54), with the Arcadia Meet the very first in the season for the earlier injured West Bakersfield star! In the 110 Highs (just twenty-one minutes after the 100) Odom was so graceful and powerful, on his way to a fire before blasting hurdle number nine, but still recording a 13.61 (+.87) clocking in leaving the field behind. This 13.61 interestingly took down the 13.70 meet Record set by Bar-

celona 200 meter silver medalist, Michael Bates. The Overbrook of Philly star amazed the huge crowd with his graceful power in both events, raising his arms in victory at the finish of the Highs that came just twenty-one minutes after his 100 win. Jay Hinton of Arizona kept Odom honest in the Highs with a fine 14.01 in second.

Julia Stamps, America's latest distance darling from Santa Rosa, impressed in the 1600. With Coach's orders to not lead the first lap, Julia was 71.2 on Elissa Riedy's shoulder after one circuit before pressing away from the field with 2:23.6 (800m) and 3:36.5 (1200) splits. Stating later that she felt strong and under control, Stamps raced in at 4:47.78 for a Meet Record, with Elissa Riedy heading a great charge behind her at 4:53.47 and some fine efforts behind her as five others broke 5:00. The Boys 1600 had 4:08 indoor mile stars Seneca Lassiter and Mike Stember come down injured, but the show put on by the others in the event was still quite impressive, with the most early-season depth ever in a U.S. prep 1600m event. A tight pack followed 61.5-2:05.5 (Brett Strahan) pacing, with a ton of people in contention at 3:10.5 (1200). Interestingly, it was Washington 1:52.4 800m star, Erik Mickelson, who was strongest over the last lap, running right at 60.0 and powerfully down the straightaway to win at 4:10.61 over surprising Larry Henderson of San Diego 4:10.97, with tenth place in the field 4:13.78! The Boys 3200 had a new star emerge with a huge presence. Another very strong field had Utah's Corbin Talley lead through 65.2 and 2:13.5 early splits, with Eleazar Hernandez pressing things through a 4:30.9 1600 with everyone in attendance. The latest Mead HS star, Micah Davis, helped set up the fast race, taking the lead through 68.7 (5:39.6) and 67.4 (6:47.0) splits before Arizona's surprising Mike Schneider (a transfer from Missouri where he was a 4:17 1600m runner in 1994), move by at the end of

the seventh lap (7:55.2) before charging away during a 63.5 final 400 that had him win 8:58.75 to 9:01.39 over Davis. Schneider had a lot left, with a 31.0 solo final 200m. In the Girls 3200 a nice pack rolled along through a 5:18 first 1600 before a group of four (Wisconsin's Christina Betzold, Australian Christine Argyros, Agoura's Amy Skieresz, and Montana's Emily Nay) started to pull away. The group gradually accelerated over the final four laps, with Skieresz blasting a 34 second final 200 to win 10:31.60 over Argyros 10:33.82, with the first seven finishing at 10:52.2 or better.

Melissa Price, the American record holder in the Pole Vault, impressed the big crowd, clearing 11-6 in the Pole Vault, before attempting 12-1, a height she could not quite negotiate this evening. The Kingsburg HS senior is a great first year "Abassadoress" for the new event, wowing everyone with her athletic abilities, skills, and joyfully spirited approach to the sport.

Fine Girls Hurdle action had Californian Joanna Hayes race a nation-leading 100mHH race at 13.98 (0 wind), taking Daveeta Shepherd (14.23) and Char Foster (14.37), with the Florida frosh flash under orders to take it easy on a sore quad if it bothered her in the race. Foster was allowed to run all out in the 300 Lows. Behind Morningside's Nicole Thomas until the local star seriously hit the last hurdle, Foster edged in ahead of Joanna Hayes 42.69-42.99, with Foster's time only .15 out of the National Frosh record of 42.54 by Twila Sims from 1989. Utah's Slade Combs, third in the Highs at 14.23, wanted a Winner's Watch, and in the Boys 300 Intermediates he was off to the races, with San Diego's Felix Sanchez closing down near the end, but never catching the East of Salt Lake City star, 37.04-37.19.

Great relay action brought everyone in the crowd to their feet! In the Boys 4x100 Muir of Pasadena, running an all soph squad, anchored by super Obie

Moore, was facing some strong competition, with Skyline (Oakland) 41.25 the previous weekend leading. Muir claims to own the relay events here, with Moore anchoring the squad to a U.S. High School Soph team record 41.18 clocking to win over Berkeley (41.29) and four others under 41.60! In the 4x400 event Morningside had taken the lead over Muir heading into the last leg, with Moore again rocketing the anchor, blazing 45.5 on the way to a 3:14.52 win for the Mustangs! After this final event of the meet, the crowd started a chant, "Obie, Obie, Obie," with the soph star a dynamite commodity in our sport. In the Distance Medley Bingham (South Jordan, Ut) had some tired bodies, with Lee Lorenz (1:54.62), Jeff Hopkinson (1:59.4), and Corbin Talley (9:05.86 3200m) all having run strong races beforehand. Not wanted to be denied, the Utah group had Lorenz go out at 57 seconds during his 3:08.1 1200 leg, with Clint Edmunds (50.3), and Hopkinson (1:57.5) giving Talley a narrow lead. Talley finished his 9:05 3200 an hour before the Distance Medley and had to be a bit tired. The pack, led by Long Beach Wilson, caught the Utah anchor runner just before a lap to go in his leg, but Talley dug down to run 4:22.0 in the Bingham 10:17.95 win that took some more watches home to Utah.

The Girls relays centered around a great group of sprinters. The Meet's opening Girls running event is the 4x100, with Long Beach Poly one of prep history's great groups, headlined by Andrea Anderson and Aminah Haddad. Logan (Union City) has some people who can run, with Kelly White and 20'+ Long Jumper Jernae Wright leading a strong short baton crew, and with Morningside and Muir along some good running was assured. Haddad, running the second leg of the 4x100, did not get out fast enough at the exchange, and was nearly run down by Zahaela Showe, with Logan and the others off to the

racers. The Poly anchor hand-off to Anderson also had problems, with Kelly White for Logan gone by that time, with Logan racing 45.90 (= #18 U.S. Prep team ever), with Morningside (Inglewood) also slipping in ahead of Poly 46.60-46.65. Anderson was mildly motivated for the 100, blasting away to an 11.59 win, with Kelly White next in a 11.74. Over 200 Meters, White cranked a 23.85 (-.85 wind) National leader, winning comfortably over Aminah Haddad 24.42. Going into the anchor of the 4x400 Poly, Logan, and Bishop O'Dowd (Oakland) were pretty even, with Andrea Anderson showing total recovery and re-conditioning from a hamstring problem from 1994 with a very impressive 53.0 anchor that had Poly win at 3:43.54, a Meet Record (56.7-55.5-58.5 first three legs). The Girls Distance Medley had strong Mission San Jose (Fremont) and Esperanza (Anaheim) teams battle the entire way. Lori Riedy led the first leg with a 3:38.8 1200 for MSJ, with Carrie

Caulkins 3:41.0 for Esperanza. A 60.0 400 leg had Esperanza move into the lead, with Gilbert (Az) taking over at the end of the third leg with a 2:17.4 800. Anchor runners for Esperanza, Courtney Pugmire (2:13.36 800m), and MSJ, Elisa Riedy (4:53.47 1600), had solid "earlier in meet" efforts, with Riedy four seconds down on Pugmire, the ninth place finisher from the Foot Locker National Cross Country Meet, at the start of the last leg. Elisa edged up, but in a spirited last lap contest, could never get ahead with the crowd rising to acknowledge the two star's struggle, with Esperanza winning 12:06.45-12:06.72 (Pugmire 4:59.4, Riedy 4:55.4 anchors).

A couple of new national stars emerged here. Frosh Angela Williams had been the top junior high sprinter for the last two years, with impressive 11.78 (100) and 24.03 (200) clockings in 1994 as an eighth grader. Williams has concentrated on the 400 so far this

spring, with this her first match against a top field. The determined little girl in the blue uniform in the middle of the track passed her test with flying colors, racing 54.57 in taking a top group that had four finish under 56.0. Clarence Scott had won the Sunkist Indoor Long Jump and placed eighth in the National Scholastic Indoor at 22-8. Here he moved to a new level, having wind-legal jumps of 23-11.75, 24-04.5, 24-03, and 24-06.75 on his final leap to take over the National Lead. Ronny Jenkins surprised with a 24-01 in second. Australian Saleena Roberts had run 2:04.9 this winter in her country, with 2:08 Californian, Kristie Johnston, looking forward to a top race. In what turned out to be a very exciting event, Roberts was a bit tentative, with a 65.5 first 400. The Australian and Johnston then charged away from the group, with Saleena starting to edge away down the home-stretch before Kristie dug down and just edged ahead (on the inside) at the tape in a Meet Record 2:09.63-2:09.65.

Jerome Davis took a competitive Boys 400 meter dash at 47.34.

Good weight event fields had Washington's Heather Gambill take the Girls Shot (46-09.5) and Discus (158-11). Jeremy Lingenfelter took the Boys Shot Put at 60-4 to take the third winner's watches home for his family in the last four years (brother Tyson took the 1993 and 1992 competitions). John Davis took the Discus at 189-3.

Dixon Brown showed the impressive development of this sport in Utah with a 15-6 win in the Boys Pole Vault over seven who cleared 15 feet or better. Surprising Peter Slater of California's far northern section, took the Boys Triple Jump at 47-11.5, defeating three 48-footers in the process. Pat Leonard took the Boys High Jump at 6-8, with competitive Tracye Lawyer the Girls at 5-8.
