<u>Seed the track finals by place, then time</u>. (SCVAL vote of coaches: 10-2 of the schools represented at the postseason meeting)

Section 6-A-2 of the CCS Track & Field By-laws would change from:

"Semi-Final winners will be seeded by time to the following" to "The Semi-Final heat winners would be seeded first by their times, then those that advanced by time would be seeded by their times."

Section 6. SEEDING PROCEDURES

RUNNING EVENTS REQUIRING TRIAL

- Equal heats will be formed. Heat winners, plus the next fastest times, qualify for the Finals. (League Champions and Heat winners are not "protected" in the seeding process. Athletes are seeded by time or mark.)
- 2. Semi-Final heat winners will be seeded first by their times. Those advancing on time will be seed next by their times.
- 3. Lanes in heats will be assigned in accordance with the NFHS rules by the games committee.
- 4. <u>Stagger-Start:</u> In the Section Meet, the stagger-start for all running events, except the 800m, 1600m and 3200m, will be the same as used at the current year's CIF State Meet.
- 5. <u>Alley-Start:</u> In the Section Meet, the alley-start will be used for the 800m, 1600m and 3200m. Seeding for these races will be the same as used for the CIF State Meet.

DATE OF REQUESTED IMPLEMENTATION: 2019 Track & Field championships

RATIONALE IN SUPPORT OF PROPOSAL:

There should be a positive reward for winning your heat by getting better seeding in the finals. Also, wind conditions can vary between races, resulting in an unfair advantage over other heats. This year in the VG 100m CCS Trials, one heat had a wind reading of 3.5 while another had a wind reading of .1. The heat with the highest wind reading had 3 qualifiers to the Finals and 3 of the 4 fastest times. This resulted in 2 qualifiers who advanced on time, were seeded higher than 2 automatic qualifiers (heat winners).

POSSIBLE OBJECTIONS TO PROPOSAL:

The CCS has traditionally followed the procedures used by the CIF State Meet which seeds solely on time.

"LANE ASSIGNMENTS FOR FINAL RACES Lanes will be assigned with the same priority, with the fastest qualifier in lane #5. Final lane assignments will be assigned by time only."
