By-Laws Update

Article II, Section 1: 15 competitions should be changed to 14 (CCS change) – no vote needed, remind AD Liaison to update the by-law at postseason meeting.

Article V, Section 14: needs to be updated due to Covid-19. It involves the rotation for hosting the league meets. Bring it up at the postseason meeting.

Admission Charge for Division Meets, SCVAL:

\$8-general admission, \$5-students, seniors and children 6 and above, Free-children 5 and under from Article XVI, Section 1.1 in SCVAL Constitution.

<u>CCS Meeting – Thurs., Jan. 27</u> Semifinals – Sat., May 14 Finals – Sat., May 21 Official Time Schedule will be published in April. Officials for the field events should arrive at least 30 minutes before the start time for warm ups. Officials must be present for safety issues during warm ups. Job Assignments for CCS Semifinals and Finals: schools should provide a coach or knowledgeable adult for turn judging. They must stay until their shift is over and next shift shows up.

Workers should arrive ready to work 45 minutes before the start of the event. Flags and paperwork will be provided for turn judges. HJ official should bring measuring tape and pencils. A \$100 fine or loss of entry for next year's meet could be levied if a league does not provide

personnel for their events on time.

Coach of record must accompany their athletes to the state meet (CIF rule).

New League, PSAL, will get 2 qualifiers. BOM will vote on a proposal to keep 32 automatic entries in a few days. If it is approved, the automatic qualifiers from each league will be updated.

All scrimmages must be held before first league dual meet, otherwise it counts as 1 of your contest.

NFHS Rule Changes

Every head coach should have a copy of NFHS Track Rules Book, provided by the league. Also, coaches should consider buying a copy of NFHS Track Officiating Book and a Case Book, \$10.00 each, at least every few years.

Please review NFHS handout for rule changes and clarification of some rules.

Dual Meets, League Meets, SCVAL

Time schedule for dual meets, league and SCVAL is set by the By-laws.

Division Trials and Finals – Field – 3pm, Running – 4pm The first alternates for sprints (100m, 200m and 400m) & hurdles (100/110m & 300ih) should be present at the League Finals to fill any lanes do to scratches. If there is a scratch and they don't run, they may be ineligible for the SCVAL meet.

Field events- Officials: should be experienced and show up at least 30 minutes prior to the start time of the event. Per CCS: no warming up at field events until an official is in place to supervise the contestants. Official needs to stay vigilante during warm ups and competition, please keep competitors and spectators in a safe area.

Dual meets – prior to meet day, coaches should discuss any changes in meet set up: field event order, etc. Both coaches should agree with changes. If there is a change of start time for a dual meet, the Home Head Coach is required to submit a Change of Schedule form.

Meet Directors for League Trials/Finals and SCVAL

All job assignments should be filled, preferable with experienced workers, especially for the throws. There should be a starting line clerk if there is only 1 starter assigned to the meet. The starting line clerk will assist the starter with insuring the athletes are in the appropriate lanes and give last minute race instructions.

Turn Judges should be assigned for the whole meet.

There should be a Field Result Checker to verify the results and make sure that they are entered correctly into the computer.

Field Event Officials need to review the rules for checking out of an event and competing out of order. These rules are usually determined by the Games Committee (Head Coaches). Athletes should only compete out of order if they have a conflict with another event. If an athlete needs to go to another event, they may take jumps/throws out of order or multiple jumps/throws. They

should have a time limit on how long they may be gone from the event, usually around 10 minutes. For the high jump, if the competitor is gone too long, the official can decide to put the cross bar up to the next height. It is not fair to the athletes still jumping, to make them wait for a competitor to come back from another event. Competitors returning from a running event, should immediately check back in at their field event but the official should allow them a few minutes to recover.

For tracks with no curb, cones should be placed on the inner edge of the track. It is best to have as many cones as possible. NFHS rules state the maximum distance between cones should be 5 feet apart.

Discus is measured to the lesser inch; the field result checker should remove any quarter or half inches from the mark.

Meet Director should only direct the meet. All coaches need to help with meet management, unfortunately we can't just coach our athletes.

Starters have been requested from the scheduler, Mark Greenough, for Division Meets, SCVAL

Hank Lawson is timing Leagues, SCVAL: keep him in the loop by including him on all emails for the League Trials/Finals and SCVAL Meets.

Wind gauges should be used at the long and triple jumps and implements weighed and checked for the throws.
