Entry Information

Entry Acceptance	To keep events manageable, priority will be given to full 3C2A, NCAA & NAIA teams attending the meet. Unattached, post collegiate and club teams will be considered on an event by event basis and will not be accepted if doing so would require adding an additional flight. This is so we can run an efficient meet for the teams attending.
Entry Procedure	All entries will be completed through www.athletic.net . Being accepted into the meet is not the same as manually entering your event and mark on athletic.net. Only 2026 verified marks will be able to be entered. If your athlete improves their performance between the time you enter and the entry deadline, please double check their entry mark. Since this is an April meet athletes/relays that do not have a 2026 mark will be entered as "no mark."
Entry Fees	Entry fees are \$50 per athlete, \$300 per team (men and women are considered separate teams). \$100 entry fee for every late entry request after the deadline. This includes changing or adding events athletes were not previously entered in on time. Entry fees will be collected at packet pickup. Checks should be made payable to the De Anza College Track & Field . Do not mail payment. This meet information was posted early. Request checks for pick up so you can pay at packet pick up. Cash is also accepted.

Meet Information

Athlete Check-In	Running Events: Athletes must check in with the clerk <u>before</u> the start of the preceding event (<u>not heat</u>), regardless of gender. Athletes should review what event/heat/lane they are in before reporting to the clerk. Heat sheets will be posted by the clerk so that athletes can check in efficiently. Relay teams must turn in a relay card when they check in at the clerk. The clerk will be located at the shed near the finish line / southwest corner of the track. Field events: Athletes must check in prior to the start of their event with the head official at the event site.
Coaching Access	Field event coaches will have access to designated coaching boxes on the infield during the competition to ensure safety for participants in various events going on at once.

Electronic Devices	Meet management will enforce electronic device restrictions consistent with NCAA safety standards Please refrain from using electronic devices in the warm-up and competition areas.
Facility Access	Team access to the De Anza College Stadium and Soccer Field will begin 2 hours prior to the first event.
Heat Sheets & Live Results	Heat sheets will be in your packet given at check in. Live results will be available at www.LynbrookSports.com . Final results will also be uploaded to athletic.net .
Media Contact	All sports media personnel are required to stay outside the competition area, on the cement walkway beyond the black perimeter fence. No media credentials will be issued for this event.
Meet Admission	Spectators: Admission is free. If you or someone attending would like to volunteer at one of the event sites please contact poncedeleonandy@deanza.edu . Track & Field meets require a generous number of volunteers. Thank you for supporting our athletes.
Parking	<p>Parking is free and available in all lots. Pay close attention to signage; staff parking, event parking etc. This meet information was written and posted prior to the possibility of events being added to the campus the same day as our competition.</p> <p>Buses may drop off and pick up parking lot C where space is available. This is the closest lot to the northwest entrance to the track. See attached map.</p>
Practice	<p>The De Anza College track & field facility will be open for practice Thursday from 3:00- 5:00pm. We will not accommodate requests for earlier or later practices outside the following times.</p> <p>3:00pm-5:00pm Track, Jumps & Shot put. 3:00pm-4:00pm Hammer (email to confirm). Same field as Javelin. 4:00pm-5:00pm Javelin (email to confirm). Same field as Hammer. 4:00pm-5:00pm Discus (email to confirm) Friday, track only, no field events from 9:00am-4:00pm.</p>
Pole Shipping	Please do not have pole vault poles shipped to De Anza. Poles must be shipped to your hotel.
Preferred Lanes	5-6-4-7-3-8-2-9-1. Teams may not “scratch & swap” their athletes. Lanes & heats will be filled by seeded marks.
Spike Check	Only 1/4” pyramid spikes are permitted (3/8” recessed pyramid spikes are permitted for High Jump & Javelin). No needles. Please help us preserve the facility with the appropriate spikes.
Starting Heights	<p>Approximate starting heights and increments will be determined upon conclusion of entries.</p> <p>Women’s High Jump- TBD Men’s High Jump- TBD Women’s Pole Vault- TBD Men’s Pole Vault- TBD</p>
Tape	Tape for any marking on the track must be white athletic tape. NO other tape will be allowed. Chalk is prohibited for any marking. Athletes caught using chalk to mark will be disqualified.
Team Camps	Team camps will be on the top row of the bleachers or in dirt area on the east side of the track. Additional team camps can be placed on the soccer field.
Warm-ups	<p>Running Events: The soccer field will be available for warm-ups. Please bring your own starting blocks for warm-ups. There is also a dirt trail nearby called the Union Pacific Trail near McClellan Rd. and Bubb Rd. for longer warm-ups and cool downs.</p> <p>Field Events: All field event athletes will have access to their event sites ~30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of competition. Throws events will roll directly into the next listed gender ‘to follow’. Athletes should remain near the event site once the preceding competition concludes. If all athletes are present and ready, officials may begin competition early; however, the posted warm-up window will not be shortened for late arrivals.</p>
Weather Policy	The meet will run rain or shine and will roll to avoid inclement weather. In the event the stadium must be cleared, everyone can take shelter in the De Anza parking structure located north east of the track. Please follow all PA instructions regarding weather.

Weight-Room

Any visiting team using De Anza weight rooms will need their S&C or ATC present in the room. If their S&C is in the room then the ATC just needs to be on campus and immediately available in the event of an emergency. Contact poncedeleonandy@deanza.edu to check availability.

Weigh-Ins

Implement inspections will be held in the Track & Field equipment shed, accessible through the northwest gate and proceeding to the other end of the stadium along the main stands. Inspections for all throwing events will begin ~1.5 hours prior to the scheduled start of competition. All implements need to be inspected no later than 1 hour prior to the scheduled start of competition. Implements will be transported to the event site 35 minutes prior to the scheduled start of competition.
