

Bruin Runners Sweep National Cross Country

UCLA runners made a "sweep" yesterday in the national junior individual and team cross country championships at Berkeley's Aquatic Park.

The Bruins came up with the first five finishers and bagged the team trophy with 15 points. California was second with 49 points and San Jose third with 65 points.

UCLA's Larry Carter won the race, shortened to six miles instead of the usual 10,000 meters because of rain, in the good time of 30:27. He was followed across by teammates Jerry Withers, Marty Donahue, Charles Phillips and Bob Zuniga.

Because of a bad cold, Walt Boehm of the Olympic club dropped out after two miles. At the time he held a slight lead over the field.
