Runners may **ONLY** enter a maximum of 3 events in any and all trials and 3 events in all finals.

Eligibility — Runners on your team **must** be employees of your company and must have been employed continuously since 4/24/83 for 32 hours per week.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE EXECUTIVE AND PRESIDENT'S RELAYS

In order to avoid misunderstanding or confusion in the president's or executive's relays, the following eligibility requirements have been established by the Corporate Cup Association for the Corporate Cup Relays:

President's Relay: Participants must have the title of President, Vice-President, or chairman of the board. They are the top-line officers of the corporation, personally entrusted with the direction and administration of all corporation decisions and policy making. They must have a hierarchy of first-line executives reporting to them.

Executive Relay: Participants in executive relays are senior administrators, 30-plus years old, who have managers and/or supervisors reporting to them through an organized chain of command.

Companies that do not possess the standard president, vice-president hierarchy will be counseled on an individual basis as to eligibility requirements.

In consideration of your accepting our entry, we, intending to be legally bound, hereby waive and release any and all right and claims against the Corporate Cup Association, the Meet Director, the Corporate Cup Relays sponsors, *Runner's World* Magazine, and any municipality and state in which the event is conducted while participating in or traveling to or from the Corporate Cup Relays. We further attest that we are physically fit and have sufficiently trained for these events. We also give permission for our names and photographs to be used in connection with reporting and publicizing the Corporate Cup Association and the Corporate Cup Relays.

- b) Only times and events run in the Official Corporate Cup Relay series will be accepted for qualifying for the Nationals.
- c) The CCA membership fee has been raised to \$150 per year per corporation.
- d) The divisions have been rearranged as follows:
Class AA-Any corporation, institution or association with more than 1,000 employees.
Class A-Any corporation, institution or association with 1,000 or less employees.
- e) Teams can travel to any official site to compete in the location of their choice.
- f) Age classification (Master's, Executive, President's) apply to any individual whose birthdate falls within the calendar year.
- g) All ties will be broken by referring to the placement of the top male finisher in the Men's 10K.
