### ATTACHMENT A

## FORMALIZATION OF USCAA AFFILIATION

Deadline: January 1, 1987

<u>Introduction</u>. The USCAA is a formal legal non-profit corporation. It has been given a 501(c)(3) status by the IRS. That means not only are we a non-profit organization but that contributions to the organization are tax deductible to the contributor.

Legal Status of Regional Organizations. Unless you have incorporated, you have the legal status on an unincorporated association. Whatever your legal status, you are liable for state and Federal taxes on all 1986 income, regardless of whether you made any profit or what you did with it. In other words, the money you took in this year to put on events is taxable, and April 15th is coming. If you have 501(c)(3) status or have been afforded some other tax-exempt status by the IRS, you will not have to pay taxes though tax returns may have to be filed.

Regions can piggy-back on the corporate status and tax status of the national body, if a formal request for recognition as the regional affiliate has been made and that request accepted by the national board. To date the USCAA has given tacit recognition to eleven regions, but that informality does not meet the requirements of state or federal law. This is to invite you to change that.

To obtain the corporate and/or tax status of the USCAA, each regional organization must formally apply to the national board for recognization as the governing body for that area, and have the board formally accept and recognize that organization as such. Then, the corporate status and tax-exempt status of the USCAA can be conferred on such group on the basis of the authority vested in the USCAA.

If you are not already incorporated, you can become a regional affiliate and derive your corporate status from the USCAA. Some registration of that fact will have to be made with the state or local governing body where you are headquartered.

Those already incorporated, or new affiliates, can also piggy-back on the USCAA's tax status, provided their purpose is the same as that of the national body. That will be no problem as USCAA bylaws require regional governing bodies to have constitutions which are not inconsistent with the national bylaws.

IMPORTANT: Local groups must be formally recognized as regional affiliates from here on out, otherwise the national body could lose its corporate and tax status. Unless a group is recognized as a regional governing body, the USCAA can not include it in any USCAA activities.

To get on board, please prepare a formal request to have your group recognized by the national board as the governing body in your region, as per the following instructions.

# Application for Affiliation with the USCAA

If you wish to become the USCAA governing body and affiliate for your region, please submit a formal request in writing addressed to the USCAA Board of Directors in care of James Kanagy, 11 Rainbow Ridge, Irvine, CA 92715.

Your request for affiliation should contain the following:

- 1) An introductory paragraph requesting that your named organization be recognized by the board of directors of the United States Corporate Athletics Association as the governing body for corporate athletics in your region. Give the general geographic scope of your region. A statement that if your request is granted, that your organization will abide by the rules and standards of the USCAA set out in its bylaws as amended from time-to-time and such rules and standards as are now in effect and which may be instituted in the future.
- 2) Give the exact name of your organization. If your are not incorporated, your name will need to be that of XYZ, division of the United States Corporate Athletics Association. For example, the "Southern California Corporate Athletics Association, a division of the USCAA."
- 3) Please state whether you are incorporated and if so, in what state. Appropriate corporate identification should be included. If not incorporated, please request that your group and its officers be given the authority to carry out business in your region as a division (if unincorporated) or affiliate (if incorporated) of the USCAA.
- 4) A copy of your bylaws or other organic document or a statement to the effect that you are adopting the bylaws of the National Organization. Please note, this document may not be inconsistent with the national bylaws. (A copy of the national bylaws will be forwarded under separate cover in about 10 days.)
- 5) Give the geographic scope of your region. If not defined by state boundries, please recite the political sub-units comprising your region.
- 6) List your Board of Directors and Officers and their membership affiliation. USCAA bylaws require at least three board members/officers. Only persons from member organizations can serve as board members. Only one person per membership can serve on the governing body.
- 6) A statement of the number of memberships for 1986. A minimum of eight (8) members is required by the USCAA bylaws in order to be officially recognized as a regional affiliate.
- 7) The mailing address and telephone number of your groups' office. If your chief evecutive has a different mailing address and phone number, please so indicate.

#### ATTACHMENT B

# 1987 Memberships and Membership Fees

Corporate membership resides in the regional organizations, not the national body. Any teams participating in your events must be a member of your region. Only groups with a facility in your region can be a member of your region. Memberships are renewed annually.

The Board has decided to drop its minimum regional fee structure of last year in favor of a minimum reimbursement system. Each regional is free to set its own membership dues from which it will then reimburse the national organization \$15 for each 1987 membership.

The National Board will invoice each region twice, once in July and again in December. The July invoice will cover memberships as of July 1st and the December invoice will cover any groups joining after July 1st 1987.

No action is needed at this time on this item.

#### ATTACHMENT C

# 1986 Membership Numbering System

<u>Introduction</u>. The Board has voted to institute a regional numbering system based on zip code and a ramdonly assigned a four digit number. The zip code will identify the region and the four digit number will identify a particular membership. A fuller explanation of the system is attached along with your pre-assigned regional number and the random number tables needed for individual members.

Application. Please assign each corporate member a number using the enclosed system. Remember, one corporate membership may field any number of teams in any given event except a national championship. All 1987 entry forms should provide for recitation of this membership number. The national group will use this numbering system to confirm that teams participating in national championships have at least one regional membership.

Record Keeping. Once a member has been assigned a number, three groups need to be made aware of that number, the member, the national group, with one copy for your file. For your convenience, a suggested membership form is attached which can be filled out once, then copied twice, to meet these record keeping requirements. Once you have entered the pertinent information and made your copies, simply check the appropriate box and send that copy to the indicated group. Mailings to the national group should be mailed to the USCAA secretary, Jim Kanagy, 11 Rainbow Ridge, Irvine, CA 92715. Good Luck.

# Digital Sponsorship of 1987 USCAA Track Series Deadline - January 1, 1987

Introduction. The knight in shining armor has appeared and, behold, he has a VAX system with which to slay the dragon. Digital Equipment Corporation, DEC, is sponsoring the 1987 National Track Championships through a cash donation and advertising. It will support the National Track Championship and the regional activities through an extensive advertising program. A designate from you region to work with Digital is needed.

DEC Advertising. DEC will advertise in national magazines such as Forbes and Fortune. Such ads and/or articles will focus on the national and regional track activities. DEC will also place ads in local newspapers and magazines for each regional championship under the present plan. DEC is covering these expenses. A lot of money is involved in this advertising. In essence, they are using the USCAA's 1987 track series as a focal point for advertising their new products. Presently we are responsible for advertising in running magazines, but that is being discussed with DEC to see whether they will pick up the tab.

Regional Sponsorship. Each region will have the opportunity to contact the DEC regional sales manager in its area and request cash support for its regional track championship. We must designate a person in each region to work with DEC on advertising and sponsorship. Dick Joseph will then put your designate in touch with DEC personnel and turn things over to your group for follow-up. Please note, region are not prohibited from seeking money from other sponsors under this arrangement, but DEC will still have the right to advertise your event under its name.

I trust our activities will support and warrant DEC's investment of this amount of time and money in our organization.

#### ACTION ITEMS

The following action items and responses are needed from your organization.

- Designation of contact for DEC. Deadline: January 1, 1987.

Please designate one person to be the sole contact with DEC. This will reduce confusion and misdirection. Responsibilities will cover all interactions with the DEC home office and the DEC regional personnel to coordinate your advertising and develop sponsorship and such other matter as need to be taken care of with Digital.

#### ATTACHMENT E

# Regional Tract Championships: Date and Contact Deadline: January 1, 1987

EVENT DATE. Advertising lead-time in national magazines is approximately three (3) months. To make May issues, we must reserve space and have materials available by the first week of January. Please, immediately set a date for your regional championship so advertising copy may be prepared.

CONTACT PERSON. Please designate one person as the regional contact for your track championship. I recommend this be someone other than the DEC contact, if possible, but leave that to your discretion. A name, address and telephone number are required. This data will be placed in national and local ads and articles prepared by DEC and the USCAA.
