

Harriers Compete At Spartan Field

Cross country teams from this area will compete in the second meet of the season this afternoon on the 1.55 mile San Jose State College course, which is serving as one of four centers within the north coast section.

The first meet of the campaign was held last week on the same course with James Lick edging Palo Alto in the feature meeting. Viking junior Ron Larriou established a new course mark of 8:09.0 and he is expected to pace the field again today.

Other schools which probably will be represented include Bishop O'Dowd of Oakland, Belarmine, San Jose, Menlo-Atherton, Campbell, Los Gatos and Santa Clara and possibly several others.
