Palo Alto picked to win north state x-country meet

Palo Alto's cross-country team, considered by many as the finest among the nation's high schools, is a heavy favorite to win tomorrow's Northern California championship running at the Stanford golf course.

Starting time is 11 a.m. at the second tee of the course.

Palo Alto already has won the Peninsula Athletic League title along with the North Coast Section group and NCS finals. Ron Larrieu, the Vikes' PAL mile champion last spring, is one of the individual favorites.

Other schools entered are Placer of Auburn, El Camino of Sacramento, Carlmont and San Francisco's George Washington and Lowell.

Additional late entries received today were Merced and Fresno and the central section individual winner, Miles Eisenmann of Tehachapi.

Rally favored to win 3rd cross country title

Palo Alto's strong cross-country team, already winner of the Peninsula Athletic League and North Coast Section, is a solid choice to win the Northern California prep championships Saturday morning at the Stanford golf course.

Other schools entered are Placer of Auburn, El Camino of Sacramento, Washington and Lowell of San Francisco, and Carlmont.

Paly wins north state cross-country

Palo Alto today ruled as the champion of Northern California prep cross country after winning over three other sectional team winners in the first annual running of the meet at Stanford golf course Saturday.

The Palo Altans, already claiming the Peninsula Athletic League and North Coast Section titles, scored 37 points to place ahead of all other entries. Lowest score wins in cross country meets.

Ron Larrieu, the PAL mile champ last spring, lead the winners as he toured the 1.9 mile course in 10:12 to defeat Tom Jent of Carlmont by 25 yards.

Miles Eisenmann, the Central Section titlist from Tehachapi, led the field by 50 yards for all but the final 200 yards. Eisenmann toured the first mile in approximately 4:50.

Larrieu, who has lost only one endurance race in three years of competition, was one of seven Palo Alto runners who finished in the first 22 places. Larrieu's lone defeat came earlier this season by Jent, the Carlmont ace.
