

Dulong Is Second to Georgetown Star— Villanova Wins

On a rain-swept course, ankle-deep in mud in places, Steve Stageberg of Georgetown captured the I.C. 4-A university-division cross-country crown with ease yesterday at Van Cortlandt Park, the Bronx.

The Hoya harrier, exhibiting top form despite the slippery terrain, was clocked in 24 minutes 32.4 seconds, surprisingly fast time in view of the conditions.

Second at the end of the five-mile grind was Arthur Dulong, the defending champion from Holy Cross. Last year, he beat Stageberg by almost 25 seconds.

Yesterday, however, it was all Stageberg. The Georgetown senior, who lives in Eugene, Ore., passed Dulong and a few others at the 1½-mile mark. He spent the rest of the journey doing his splashing up front, alone, and won by 60 yards.

Weather No Deterrent

The Intercollegiate Association of Amateur Athletes of American competition, as usual, drew a huge field despite weather more conducive to flu than foot racing. More than 1,000 collegians from 69 campuses in the East and Midwest took part in the four-event program.

In team competition, the story was a familiar one. Villanova, the two-time defending titleholder, did it again. The Wildcats, with 63 points, won the varsity division from Georgetown with 86. As a bonus, they rewarded Coach Jumbo Elliott with the freshman crown as well, displacing the Hoyas' cubs.

"I thought we had a good chance to take that varsity

championship," said Elliott. "But I had another concern. I was hoping that in all that horrible weather my boys would remain healthy. After all we also have to defend here in next Monday's N.C.A.A. championships."

In keeping with Stageberg's emphatic success, Ronald Stonetech, the C. W. Post runner who trains on Long Beach's sandy oceanfront strips near his home on Long Island, scored impressively in the college varsity section.

The Post star boasted more than a 200-yard lead after only

three miles. He rushed home in 25:43.2 to top Ben Wilson of Massachusetts Institute of Technology by a runaway margin of 41.8 seconds.

Wilson led M.I.T. to the team title, replacing Springfield, by scoring 73 points. Springfield was second with 103.

Dulong suffered another disappointment after the race. He was told by his coach, Dick Donohue, that, through an oversight at Holy Cross, his entry had never been filed for the I.C.A.A. title event. The deadline was Nov. 12.

Stageberg Student Of Harrier Mistakes

The more Steve Stageberg runs the cross country course at Van Cortlandt Park, the Bronx, the smarter he gets. Yesterday the Georgetown University senior reversed last year's defeat by Art Dulong of Holy Cross in the 60th annual IC4A University Division championships.

The 21-year-old Hoya from Eugene, Ore., splashed his way through the five miles of rain and mud in 24:32.4 to beat Dulong by 40 yards.

Now comes the NCAA title meet on Monday, and once again it will be held at Van Cortlandt. Will Stageberg have an advantage over the rest of the country?

"Yes," said Stageberg, a 5-10, 145-pounder. "Every time I come here I run a smarter race. As a sophomore in this meet I ran one of the stupidest races in my college career.

"Last year I made a few mistakes and finished behind Dulong. However, I learned enough in a dual meet against Manhattan (he won in 24:14.4) two weeks ago to help me today."

What about the horrible weather conditions?

"Nobody likes to run in this kind of weather," said Stageberg, who is undefeated in dual meets (nine) over the last two years.

"You have to make the most of it. The mud was bad, especially on the flats, but there was no thought in my mind that the race would be postponed.

"It gets so that you can expect anything in cross country."

Dick Buerkle of Villanova was third and set the stage for Jumbo Jim Elliott's

Wildcats to win the team crown for the third straight year. Georgetown was second.

Steve Stageberg of Georgetown reversed the 1967 order of finish when he defeated Arthur Dulong of Holy Cross by 40 yards in 24:32.4. This was well off Dulong's record of 24:04.4, set last year, but sloppy footing underneath and a steady rain throughout the race made a record pace impossible. Dulong ran 24:44 yesterday.

Among First 25

Villanova had all five of its runners among the first 25 across the line. Bald-pated Dick Buerkle outsprinted Jerry Richey of Pittsburgh for third place in 25:02. Veteran Tom Donnelly, third a year ago, was sixth this time. Then came the Wildcat foreign contingent, Chris Mason of Sheffield, England, in 12th place, Murphy, a Dubliner, in 21st place, and Des McCormack, who also hails from the Irish capital, in 24th place.

Murphy was running under the special provision that allowed Olympic athletes to compete even though they are not in school this term. Marty Liquori of Cedar Grove, a Villanova sophomore, passed up this privilege to save his eligibility for the 1971 cross-country season.

Marty will have plenty to run with the next three years. After Greg Fredericks of Penn State won the frosh race in 14:49.2, the Wildcat yearlings took over. Donald Walsh of Cork, Ireland, was second, a step back, in 14:49.3 and Dave Wright of Durham, England, third in 14:52. Three American-born runners, Wilson Smith, Byron Beam and Bill McLoughlin, placed fifth, eighth and ninth.

Was After Record

Despite his 70-yard victory yesterday, Stageberg was a disappointed runner. "I had hoped to break the record," said the 145-pound senior from Eugene, Ore. "But the weather fixed that." Stageberg took the lead at the mile and a quarter mark and had a 40-yard edge on Dulong when they passed the three-

mile post after the first trip over the slippery hills.

Stageberg will be back here Monday for the NCAA championships, being run at Van Cortlandt for the first time. "I have no idea what the competition from the West will be," he said, "but it can't be much tougher than what we have here today." Villanova will also return Monday, seeking its third consecutive IC4A-NCAA double victory.

Georgetown's second place effort was aided by three New Jersey runners. Following Stageberg over the line were two Essex Catholic grads, Greg Ryan in 16th place and Fred Lane in 33rd, while Fred Protoppas of Wayne was 23rd.

Harvard was a slight disappointment as the Heptagonal champs placed third with 121 points. Dave Pottetti led the Crimson in seventh place, while Doug Hardin of Short Hills, the Hep champ, was 36th and Tim McLoone of Maplewood 45th. Keith Colburn and Tom Spengler ran back-to-back in 18th and 19th positions.

Tigers Place 13th

Princeton failed to place among the first 10 and gain a place in the NCAA meet, finishing 13th. But the Tigers' Eamon Downey and Tom Yuncik made the grade as individuals, placing 15th and 41st.

Ron Stonitsch of C. W. Post was an easy winner in the College Division varsity race as he outdistanced the field by 42 seconds to win in 15:48.2. Massachusetts Institute of Technology, led by Ben Wilson in second place, won the team title with 73 points as the 1967 champion, Springfield, finished second with 103.

The College Division freshman race saw a 1-2 finish for New Jersey runners as Tim Steele of Denville won for Lehigh in 15:42.6, with Dale Keenan of Washington second for Lafayette in 15:53. NEW YORK—Georgetown's Steve Stageberg, a product of South Eugene High School,

sprinted by defending champion Art Dulong of Holy Cross Monday and won the IC4A cross country championship by 50 yards at Van Cortlandt Park.

Stageberg, a senior and cross country captain for the Hoyas, will now attempt to take the

NCAA honors next week on the same course.

In regular-season competition, Stageberg also outdistanced champion Villanova, getting a record with a 27:16 dual meet finish over the 5.5-mile course.

Georgetown's only loss this season came at the hands of William & Mary 31-26.

But it turned out to be just one of those days as the Hoyas' bus got lost with the runners having no time to warm up. Stageberg still was able to clock 26:10 for the individual victory against William & Mary.

This week's NCAA finals will be televised on ABC's Wide World of Sports.
