Stanford, Cal, and San Jose State along with USC will provide strong team competition. Host Sacramento State, Chico State, UC Davis, University of Pacific, Fresno State, Humbolt State, San Francisco State and Haywood State are the other contenders.

"This is our first big test," Sucec said. "This will prove if we have just a good team or a great one. We need strong team cohesion. It is starting to form now that the new people are learning our system."

The Aztec squad of Tom Davidson, Roger Friend, Tim Danielson, Alan Leverenz, Pete Virgadamo, Dave Hamblen and Skip Crowley is ready both mentally and physically for this meet, Sucec feels.

The SDS squad improvement has been staggering this season. Hamblen covered the Whittier Invitational course in 21:24 - 64 seconds faster than last year. Crowley covered the same course 66 seconds faster than a year ago and Friend was 22 seconds faster than in 1967.

The Aztecs covered the Whittier course in an average time of 21:41. This was an improvement of 24 seconds over last season and seven seconds faster than USC's winning time of 21:48 last year.
