Reprint from San Jose Mersury (Oct. 13)—"Sacramento. Stanford's cross country runners produced the biggest shakeup of the year in national collegiate cross country ratings by nipping USC in the Sacramento State Invitational meet on Saturday. Stanford, behind Brook Thomas's 4th place finish and 7th, 8th, 14th, and 16th place efforts by Allen Sanford, Don Kardong, Greg Brock, and Chuck Menz respectively, trimmed the top rated Trojans 49-50."

To this we might add Duncan Macdonald's 18th place finish in front of SC's 5th man, and a good performance by Bob Anchondo finishing 31st in a field of over 110 runners. In the huge (nearly 200 runners) of Frosh-Junior College competition, Stanford yearlings turned in an electrifying performance. Robert Coe and Jack Lawson finished 1-2 when they were finally able to find the finish line amidst confusion and mud. This was Coe's first ever win in any kind of cross country competition. The frosh team effort was equally impressive as George Watson finished 10th, followed by Bruce McCormmach (13th), Bernie Lahde (22nd), Dave Whiteing (29th), and Dick Jaffe (43rd).
