A JOB WELL DONE BY THE STANFORD VARSITY AND FROSH TEAMS . . . UNDEFEATED IN ALL COMPETITION FOR THE REGULAR 1968 CROSS COUNTRY SCHEDULE . . .

The final meet of the season proved to be hectic and challenging for the Indians. At the outset there were some thoughts as to whether we would ever find the course. Once we found the "reservoir", new challenges were encountered in the form of Bob Waldon and Clifton West of the hosting Golden Bears. The frosh competition was first to go at 10:15 a.m.; and the West led Bears nearly scored an upset. Bob Coe had shoe problems early and was forced to stop; and 1.5 miles in to the race and the Indians were in trouble. However, at the end it was Jack Lawson finishing 2nd in the race, and a late charge by Bruce McCormmach (3rd), George Watson (4th), Arvid Kretz (7th), and Mike McClure (10th) was enough for the Indians to win 26-29. A fine team performance by the Frosh when the pressure was on.

In the varsity race Cal's Bob Waldon and Stanford's Brook Thomas staged an exciting finish over the final 300 yards with Waldon winning in the last two strides. The fast early pace made it tough on the Indian pack running time spread, however Stanford runners had no difficulty taking places 2nd through 8th. Following Brook were Greg Brock, Chuck Menz, Don Kardong, Duncan Macdonald, Al Sanford, and Bob Anchondo.
