

Tribe Wins Harrier Meet

Sequoia High won the third annual Little Big Game alumni cross country race for the first time Thursday, defeating Palo Alto 13-23.

The two-mile race was held before the Sequoia-Paly football game at Stanford Stadium, on the Indian track.

Sequoia grad Mike Dailey, now of Chico State, won with a 9:55.0 clocking, followed by Sequoia's Jose Cortez in 10:00 and former Cherokee Joel Stein in 10:02.

Mike Renahan was the first Paly finisher in fourth with a 10:04 clocking. Oldest competitor was Mike Ipsen, a vintage Sequoian now notorious as coach of the Redwood City Striders.
