

# Wildcat runners beat M-A

Led by seniors Mark Llewellyn and Damon Wood, Woodside High nipped host Menlo-Atherton in an eight-team cross

country meet Monday on the Bears' 2.2-mile course.

Meanwhile, in another meet at Carlmont, the strong Scots placed six runners in the top 15 finishers for a 39-point total to roll past Overfelt (72), San Rajnon (78), Riordan (94), Gunn (103) and Los Altos (104).

Llewellyn finished third in 10:42 and Wood fifth in 11:01 for Woodside, which had 69 points to top M-A (69), Bellarmine (91), Terra Nova (96), Sequoia (113) and Menlo School (124). Cubberley and Palo Alto didn't field full teams.

Cubberley ace Stacy Geiken won at M-A in 10:15.5, breaking his own two-week-old course record of 10:21.3. Dave Hull, M-A's promising junior, was second in 10:28, the route's fastest non-Geiken clocking.

"I was happy we were only a point away from Woodside dualwise (27-28)," said M-A coach Plato Yannicks. "I think it'll be a tight battle between M-A, Woodside and San Carlos for second place (behind Carlmont) in the South Peninsula Athletic League finals."

At Carlmont, where heavy winds slowed times on the 2-mile course, Scot

junior Ed Young was second in 9:59, while mate John Shroyer was next, one second behind. San Ramon's Roy Kissin won in 9:49.

"We're running well," said coach Loren Lansberry, whose Scots are 9-1, the loss to St. Francis by only a dual point. "We're looking ahead past the league finals, to (toughies) Leigh and St. Francis."
