Rules: C.I.F. Rules will apply as stated in the Cross Country Handbook.

Dressing: Locker, shower and restroom facilities are available. No towels
or lockers will be provided.

Awards: Trophy's will go first, second and third places in Freshmen, Sophomore, Junior Varsity and Girls' Team Races.

Medals: Medals will go to 10 individual finishers in Junior Varsity and Open Races. Trophy to outstanding coach based on school total from the Freshman, Sophomore and Varsity team totals.
